Introduction

Lanzerac's winemaking history started in 1914 when the owner, the formidable Mrs Elizabeth Katherina English, bottled the first Lanzerac wine from grapes grown on her land where there were believed to have been 21 imported varietals growing.

The present Lanzerac winemaking team honours the memory of this formidable lady through the Mrs English Chardonnay.

The year 1925 saw the birth of South Africa's first indigenous wine grape variety, Pinotage, which was a cross between Pinot Noir and Hermitage. In 1961, Lanzerac became the first winery in the world to use the term 'Pinotage' on their label when they marketed the 1959 vintage under the name 'Lanzerac'.

This visionary release marked the birth of Pinotage as a unique variety from South Africa. To this day, Lanzerac, under the leadership of winemaker Wynand Lategan and viticulturist Philip Le Roux, is still producing award-winning Pinotage wines along with a wide variety of other cultivars of excellent quality.

Sparkling Wine

Méthode Cap Classique

Méthode Cap Classique (MCC) is the term that describes the South African bottle-fermented sparkling wines produced in the French Méthode Champenoise style, whereby the second fermentation has to take place in the bottle that the wine will be served from. The name was derived from the fact that the classic art of winemaking was introduced to the Cape by the French Huguenots. The first bottle-fermented sparkling wine, called Kaapse Vonkel (Cape Sparkle), was produced in South Africa in 1971. Pinot Noir and Chardonnay are commonly used to make the premium styles of these wines, but other varieties like Sauvignon Blanc and Chenin Blanc are also extensively used. These sparkling wines are perfect for celebrations!

The creaminess on the palate is complemented by the subtle and refreshing acidity of the wine. Salinity carries through on the palate alongside restrained oak spiciness.





Sparkling Wine

Champagne

Champagne, a sparkling wine produced in the Champagne region of France and primarily made from Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes, must be made in the Méthode Traditionnelle, meaning the second fermentation process must take place in the same bottle that it is served from. The history of the invention of sparkling wine sparks debate as the French Benedictine monk (Dom Perignon) is often and erroneously credited with having invented sparkling wine in 1697. Records, however, have shown that an English physician, Christopher Merret, had documented attempts to intentionally create a sparkling wine long before Perignon. It is clear, however, that the French played the most important role in perfecting the art of making sparkling wine.

LOUIS ROEDERER COLLECTION, 242/243 CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

Bright, golden hue with shimmering highlights. Fine, lively mousse with lingering threads of bubbles. The bouquet is open and rich yet also wonderfully fresh. It offers an explosion of ripe, delicate fruit with intense notes of yellow fruit (mirabelle plum) from the Pinot noir complemented by sweet citrus fruits (lemon meringue pie) and delicate notes of white flowers (jasmine) from the Chardonnay. The nose opens up to reveal autolytic characters and evolves towards smoky, roasted notes and freshly baked pastries. The palate is deep and dense with a big, well-structured backbone





Sparkling Wine

Cava & Prosecco

CAVA

This is a Spanish bottle-fermented sparkling wine. Cava is typically made from Spanish indigenous grape varieties, namely Macabeo, Parellada and Xarello. The production of Cava was adopted by the Spanish from the French in the late 19th Century when Joseph Ravento of the Codorníu Winery in Catalonia visited Champagne and returned to make Cava in 1872. Like many traditional sparkling wines, Cava is made in a range of styles from very dry and off-dry, to sweeter.

CODORNÍU CLASSICO BRUT NV CATALONIA, SPAIN

780

The bouquet is characterised by strong minerality and apple blossoms. Full and inviting, it embraces hints of sweet ripe fruit, meringues, pastries and candied citrus peel. On the palate, its flavour fully matches the nose, with a creamy, almost crunchy sensation, and a texture that combines elegance and lightness, depth and harmony.

PROSECCO

A sparkling wine from the great winegrowing region of Veneto in Italy. The grape variety that is essential for the production of Prosecco is called Glera, although small amounts of other varieties such as Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Grigio may be blended with it. Unlike Champagne or MCC that are made using the Traditional Method, Prosecco is mainly produced using the Transfer Method (Charmat), where the second fermentation happens in pressurised stainless steel vessels. This method produces wines with a fruity and floral nose.

VALDO DOC ORO PURO BRUT NV VENETO, ITALY

580

A fresh, pleasantly soft, lively, dry and harmonious Prosecco. Straw yellow in colour with bright reflections and some fine persistent bubbles. Typically floral with nuances of herbs and acacia flowers on the nose, and an intense fruity bouquet of pear and golden apples. The palate reveals elegant tones of ripe fruit flavours of pear, white melon and peach. Refined and harmonious with a lingering finish.

DA LUCA BRUT NV VENETO, ITALY

380

A really refreshing low-alcohol sparkler with appealing floral, citrus and stone fruit aromas. The palate is fresh and flavoursome, displaying characters of peach, apple and capsicum, with a touch of sweetness and a clean, crisp finish.





Rosé & Blanc de Noir

Rosé

These are pink wines, usually light-bodied and made by incorporating the colour of red grape skins to white juice. It is essential to understand that many red-wine grape varieties have white juice and the colour of red wines comes from the period of skin contact after crushing. There are three major ways of making rosé wine, namely short skin contact, bleeding off, and blending of red and white wine. It may be the oldest known type of wine as it is the most straightforward to make, especially using the skin contact method. The pink colours can range from a pale 'onion skin' orange to a vivid near-purple, depending on the varieties and winemaking techniques used. Fresh, fruity, light rosé wines are perfect for summer.

LANZERAC 2022 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

Made from 100% Pinotage grapes. Gentle aromatic tones of perfume and rose petals are followed by nuances of crushed strawberries and redcurrants. This wine is excellent with our selection of salads – not too dry, not too sweet, just right.

Made from 100% free-run Cabernet Franc juice, this unique Rosé displays flavours of ripe strawberries, cassis and candy floss with dark red berries and cream on the mid-palate and a juicy, crisp and dry finish.

FABLE MOUNTAIN VINEYARDS BELLE FLOWER ROSE 2019 TULBAGH

The colour is bright, pale pink with salmon hues like the Rosé you will find in the Provence. The nose is beautifully layered and complex with wild strawberries, rose petals and hints of mandarin orange and citrus blooms. Strawberries carry through on the palate accompanied with honeydew melon and baking spices like nutmeg and cardamom with subtle hints of dill and stone minerality. The finish is long with soft creamy layered flavours and mineral and fresh lingering acidity.

Rosé & Blanc de Noir

Blanc de Noir

The paradox of such wines is that the eye believes the other senses. This is a method of making white wine from red grapes and it is called 'blanc de noir' (meaning 'white from black'), more famously used in Champagne production in France, where whole-bunch pressing is used to prevent the juice from obtaining colour from the skins.

A fresh lemongrass mouthfeel with subtle minerality is rounded off by a soft creaminess in the long finish due to extended lees contact.

PASCAL JOLIVET POUILLY FUMÉ 2017 LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE

A vibrant yellow colour with a dry focused nose of citrus and mineral tones. On the palate the wine is medium in body, incredibly precise and layered with clean, driving acidity, leading to an unforgettable finish of citrus, apple, white blossom and flint rock.

Certified organic, this vibrant Sauvignon Blanc bursts with gooseberry, honeydew melon, some white peach and hints of lemon zest on the nose. The palate shows a lovely brightness, firm acidity and definite flinty notes, typical of the Reyneke site. The wine reveals multiple layers as it opens up, with rich undertones, great complexity and a long, lingering finish.

DAVID NIEUWOUDT 'GHOST CORNER' 2020

Powerful concentrated layers of green figs and gooseberries, with a touch of grapefruit, fynbos and a steely minerality on the palate. A reflection of the cool-climate terroir of Elim, the southernmost tip the continent. Lees contact during the winemaking process creates length and richness on the aftertaste.

DE GRENDDEL KOETSHUIS 2021 DURBANVILLE

560

Pale straw in colour, this wine presents an explosion of fresh lime, lemon thyme and asparagus aromas with pronounced intensity. The flavour profile comprises zesty granadilla with a slight chalkiness and wet stone. A young, medium bodied wine with high natural acidity and exceptionally long finish that has magnificent ageing potential to become fuller over time. Decant slowly to ensure optimum drinking pleasure.

SHANNON SANCTUARY PEAK 2021

Expresses very distinctive and concentrated primary fruit aromas of asparagus, citrus and some capsicum. A refreshing palate finishes off in a minerally and flinty style. Blended with a touch of Semillon to enhance body and structure.

White Wine

Chenin Blanc

Chenin Blanc is a white grape that has a very long history as it is thought to have been established in Anjou, in the Loire Valley region of France, as far back as the ninth century. It has also played a big role in the intriguing history of winemaking in South Africa, as it is believed to have been among the first vine cuttings that arrived here in 1655 during the time of Governor Jan van Riebeeck. Chenin Blanc is currently the most planted variety in South Africa because of its important role in the production of local brandy, as well as its versatility in wine production as it is made in a wide range of styles, from premium dry table wines to high quality sweet dessert wines. While most South African Chenin Blanc wines are still made in a fresh and fruity style, that is changing. More and more producers are focusing on mature bush vines and wooded styles that have given the nation a significant point of difference as we have really old Chenin vines, resulting in concentrated, full-bodied, food-friendly wines that are taking the world by storm.

MARC BRÉDIF VOUVRAY 2017 LOIRE, FRANCE

860

This ripe and refreshing wine is a brilliant pale gold. On the nose, there is a fine bouquet full of aromas of white flowers, yellow fruit such as pears and citrus notes such as grapefruit. Gentle with a lovely vivacity and agreeable notes of grapefruit on the lingering finish.

THE KAAPZICHT KLIPRUG 2022 STELLENBOSCH

500

Ripe quince, pineapple and stone fruit with some interesting savoury undertones. Lightly textured palate, with a hint of sweetness and balancing crunchy acid, results in a brisk finish.

KEERMONT 'RIVERSIDE' 2019 STELLENBOSCH

820

Riverside Chenin Blanc 2019 has a light, gold colour with a green hue. It has a bouquet of citrus blossom and apricot, with hints of cut grass, oyster shell and vanilla. The entry on the palate is soft and light at first, but then opens up with pure fruit flavours of ripe peach and apple and a touch of marzipan and vanilla. Lovely zippy acidity allows for a long, clean, textured finish with a lingering aftertaste of rich fruit and butterscotch. Drink 2022-2032.

Golden hued and full bodied, with melon and spicy baked apple aromas. Layered with mineral notes enhanced by honeycomb and caramel flavours from lees contact. This wine is a great example of the harmonious balance which can be achieved between fruit and delicate oak/vanilla flavours as they combine to form complex, soft flavours with sufficient body to enhance even spicy and full flavoured meals.

BEAUMONT FAMILY WINES 2022

BOT RIVIER

360

Our Chenin Blanc was made from 100% Beaumont, Bot River fruit. This is fruit filled unwooded Chenin Blanc. The vintage produced plenty grapes with good concentration following a beautiful and healthy growing season. It is a delicious example of cooler climate Chenin Blanc fermented in concrete and stainless-steel tanks using a combination of cultured and natural yeasts. Matured after fermentation on the lees to add some extra weight and complexity to the wine.





White Wine

Chenin Blanc

Chenin Blanc is a white grape that has a very long history as it is thought to have been established in Anjou, in the Loire Valley region of France, as far back as the ninth century. It has also played a big role in the intriguing history of winemaking in South Africa, as it is believed to have been among the first vine cuttings that arrived here in 1655 during the time of Governor Jan van Riebeeck. Chenin Blanc is currently the most planted variety in South Africa because of its important role in the production of local brandy, as well as its versatility in wine production as it is made in a wide range of styles, from premium dry table wines to high quality sweet dessert wines. While most South African Chenin Blanc wines are still made in a fresh and fruity style, that is changing. More and more producers are focusing on mature bush vines and wooded styles that have given the nation a significant point of difference as we have really old Chenin vines, resulting in concentrated, full-bodied, food-friendly wines that are taking the world by storm.

The aromas are flinty with honey, orange blossom with some notes of tropical fruit, yellow apple and ripe pear. The palate is fresh and zesty with fruity flavours following through from the nose. A mineral finish.

A big, complex and expressive wine. A dusty nose with tones of citrus, stone fruit, oak spice and a hint of toast. Rich and thick-textured but this is offset by a punchy acidity.

A big, complex and expressive wine. A dusty nose with tones of citrus, stone fruit, oak spice and a hint of toast. Rich and thick-textured but this is offset by a punchy acidity.

LONGRIDGE 2021 STELLENBOSCH (CERTIFIED ORGANIC)

Certified organic, this naturally fermented Chenin boasts mineral like notes, hints of peach, pineapple and stone white fruit, with an understated hint of oak. On the palate a gentle minerality is accompanied by a well-balanced acidity.





White Wine

Riesling

Riesling is an aromatic white grape variety that originated in the Rhine region of Germany. It is one of the most interesting grape varieties of the world, displaying flowery, almost perfumed, aromas as well as a high acidity. Riesling is made in a wide range of styles, from dry to semi-sweet, sweet and sparkling white wines. These wines are usually varietally pure and are seldom oaked. The cooler climate areas of South Africa have recently been very successful in making premium styles of this variety with producers from the Elgin region in particular getting increased recognition for their wines.

The wine is pale in colour, with a beautiful green tint. This is an expressive wine with a melody of fresh fruit and citrus blossom notes. The palate is delicate with elegantly clean and zesty lime notes with great textural feel of the mid palate. There is a great interplay between the naturally retained residual sugar and acidity. Generally regarded as restrained, it displays typical Riesling 'nervousness'. The mineral core, which is linked to the shale rich soils in which the vines grow, adds great complexity, structure and the lingering after taste.

Exudes sweet yet persistent bright, fresh limes, crisp apples and white flower perfume. The brisk acidity is well-balanced and supported by expressive fruit with spicy undertones. Secondary characteristics include a tinge of kerosene oiliness to enhance the overall texture of the wine.

The nose is filled with soft stone fruit and a smell of sweet turpentine that is distinctive and very pleasant. The palate is crisp and delicate with wonderful bright fruit of white-fleshed peach. Finishes off with fruity acidity and brilliant minerality.

Pinot Blanc & Gewürztraminer

PINOT BLANC

Much uncertainty surrounds the early history of this variety as to whether it is a genetic mutation of Pinot Noir or related to Chardonnay as its old name Pinot Chardonnay may suggest. For many years Pinot Blanc and Chardonnay were mistaken for each other, as this grape produces wines that are very similar to and usually blended with Chardonnay.

LANZERAC KELDERMEESTER VERSAMELING BERGPAD 2018 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

510

Exclusively made by our cellar master from a single vineyard on the Stellenbosch Mountain overlooking the Lanzerac facilities, Bergpad is a complex, full-bodied wine with an interplay of stone fruit and white floral notes. On the nose is preserved quince, violets, lavender and pears which follows through to the palate, where creaminess and softness enter at the mid-palate, and linger on the extended finish.

GEWÜRZTRAMINER

Gewürztraminer is, without a doubt, the most distinctively aromatic of all the white grapes. Its origins come from the Traminer variety, a green-skinned grape that takes its name from the village of Tramin, located in South Tyrol, the German-speaking province in northern Italy. It was spread to Alsace, where gewürz (spice) was added to its name. This variety produces an exotic, spicy, perfumed wine that has flavours of litchis and seems full-bodied, even if it isn't. It performs best in cooler climates.

NEETHLINGSHOF 2021/2022 STELLENBOSCH

230

Pale lemon in colour with pronounced aromas of litchi, ripe yellow apples, rose petals and hints of Turkish delight finishing off with hints of marmalade on the palate.





White Wine

Pinot Gris / Pinot Grigio & Viognier

PINOT GRIS AND PINOT GRIGIO

Pinot Gris and Pinot Grigio are in fact the exact same grape variety but the names have come to infer two different styles of wine. The immensely popular Italian-style (Pinot Grigio) wines are typically lighter-bodied, crisp and fresh with vibrant stone fruit and floral aromas, and a touch of spice. In contrast, the French Pinot Gris wines from the region of Alsace are more full-bodied, richer, spicier and more viscous in texture. They also tend to have greater cellaring and ageing potential. In South Africa Pinot Gris/Grigio is mostly made in a dry style.

USANA 2019/2020 STELLENBOSCH

350

Crisp and refreshing, this Pinot Gris displays hints of green apple, pear and sweet honeydew melon, and a fresh, flinty edge. A smooth, subtly silk-like overtone leaves a distinctive impression on the palate. A refreshing finish.

IDIOM BIANCO 2019 /2020 STELLENBOSCH

370

Pale straw yellow in colour with a delicate floral nose. Elegant flavours of pear, green melon and pineapple combine with fresh, crisp acidity and a well-structured mid-palate to make this an exceptional example of Pinot Grigio. Perfect as an aperitif.

VIOGNIER

Viognier's home is in France's northern Rhône appellations of Condrieu and Côte-Rôtie. However, it is thought to have originated in Dalmatia (Bosnia) and was imported into France around 280 AD. An early ripener and very hard to grow even in perfect conditions, it has an exuberant character that is generously perfumed and opulent but dry. In spite of lower levels of acidity, it is full-bodied with seductive flavours of apricot, peach, musk and lime blossoms.

WHALEHAVEN 2020 HERMANUS

350

Light pale straw in colour. Aromas of white pear, peach and honey blossoms are followed by flavours and textures of nougat and sweet spices. Enticing and elegant, this is a wine with good body and a long lingering finish.

TAMBOERSKLOOF 2016 STELLENBOSCH

410

A classic white gold-coloured Viognier with dominant jasmine and frangipani notes, and delicately interlacing kiwi and pear on the nose. Purely balanced with great natural acidity. On the palate the wine punches richly and finishes boldly on apricot and quince tones.

Semillon & Verdelho

SEMILLON

The Semillon grape is native to the Bordeaux region of France. A variety that produces wines considered to be perfectly food-friendly, it is appreciated for its rounded, lanolin-like quality with honey and citrus tones that are only enhanced by oak ageing. Grown mainly in the cooler regions of South Africa, these wines are usually blended with Sauvignon Blanc to add body and structure. As a single varietal wine, Semillon often displays herbaceous, grassy flavours when young but with age this wine becomes rich, luscious, even more lanolin-textured, and increasingly honeyed and toasty.

DAVID NIEWOUDT GHOST CORNER 2016 CEDERBERG

530

An aromatic Semillon displaying aromas of green fig, white fruit and nettles characteristic of the cool climate in Elim. A distinct minerality with a slight earthiness on the nose follows through onto the palate. A small amount of French oak adds a hint of smokiness, leading to a creamy palate with a crisp acidity.

STEENBERG 2019/2020 CONSTANTIA

670

Our Semillon is a beautiful pale gold colour. Aromas of apricot, cardamom and orange blossom greet you upon first inspection. Quince, hay bale and roasted almond complete the sensation on the palate. Poised, weighted fruit concentrates the mid-palate, after which the wine broadens out with a rich, almost waxy texture and bright acidity. A citrus and floral spice lingers on the palate long after the last drop. This Semillon will continue to evolve in complexity and richness with age.

VERDELHO

A Portuguese variety popularly known for its contribution to the famous fortified wines of the Madeira Islands, there are very few plantings of this variety in South Africa and the grapes are usually destined for a few blended table wines. There are a few winemakers, however, who are producing single varietal Verdelho wines with success.

STELLENBOSCH VINEYARDS 2018

STELLENBOSCH

830

Made utilising wild yeast, barrel fermented and from a single vineyard, this is an exceptional wine revealing peach and apricot aromas with flinty, floral and nutty nuances. Its zesty nature makes this a complex wine showing raw almond and dried fruit on the palate. Its well-integrated acid line contributes to the refreshing, lingering finish.





White Wine

Grenache Blanc

GRENACHE BLANC

Grenache Blanc (Garnacha Blanca) is a white grape variety that is related to the red grape Grenache Noir. It originated in northern Spain but is also found in the Rhône region of France. It is an important variety in the Rhône Valley, where it is often blended with Roussanne in the famous white wines of Châteauneuf-du-Pape.

THE FOUNDRY 2020 VOOR PAARDEBERG

570

Lifted floral aromas with hints of lemon cream and white stone fruit. The palate is rich but restrained with focused, pure fruit, a minerally mid-palate with a characteristic rich, fleshy mouthfeel and texture, and a long finish with a citrus tang.

Roussanne & Bukettraube

ROUSSANNE

Roussanne is a white Rhône variety that gets its name from the russet tone (roux) of its skin. Together with Marsanne, with which it is often blended, Roussanne is one of only two cultivars permitted in the white versions of the northern Rhône red-wine appellations of Hermitage, Crozes-Hermitage and Saint-Joseph, and in the exclusively white, often sparkling Saint-Péray. In the southern Rhône, Roussanne is one of four varieties allowed in white Châteauneuf-du-Pape. As a varietal wine or blending component, the variety remains a tiny factor in the Cape's vineyards.

KEN FORRESTER RESERVE 2020 STELLENBOSCH

740

Medium yellow with golden hues, and a huge and complex nose with dominant green figs, confit orange, marzipan and nutmeg. Luxurious oak notes upfront of a fully round mouthfeel coat the palate with lime, fig and buttered brioche toast.

Elegant, rich restrained, hints of lime blossom, soft on the palate with a gentle structure, yet remains fresh with a chalky saline acid frame. An impressive long finish.

BUKETTRAUBE

Thought to be German, although there is a variety in Alsace, France, called Bouquettraube, which is said to have originated in Würzburg ('Buket' is German for bouquet). Still grown in Alsace on a small scale, Bukettraube has not been a great traveller. First imported to South Africa in 1967, the variety adapted well. South Africa appears to be the only country outside Germany and France to have any plantings and bottles it as a single varietal wine.

CEDERBERG 2022 CEDERBERG

320

Prominent Muscat flavours with apricot and floral notes on the nose. A well-balanced wine with a delicate sweetness and a crisp acidity. Can be enjoyed as an aperitif.





White Wine

Sylvaner & Grüner Veltliner

SYLVANER

Sylvaner is the French name for the German variety known as Silvaner, although it is said to have originated in Austria. Wine from this grape has a naturally high acid level. It is still popular in areas in Germany where Riesling struggles to ripen as it ripens two weeks earlier.

OVERGAAUW 2016 STELLENBOSCH

400

The only single-varietal Sylvaner produced in South Africa, this wine is refreshing and medium-bodied with aromas of pear, apricot and white-fleshed peach, and small traces of floral and spice notes. The fruit follows through onto the palate with a pleasingly crisp, lingering finish.

GRÜNER VELTLINER

The most important grape variety in Austria, Grüner Veltliner achieved worldwide awareness and popularity at the end of the last century. It is a fertile variety and therefore requires yield regulation. It grows especially well in deep soil, does not like dryness and is sensitive during flowering.

DIEMERSDAL 2019 DURBANVILLE

330

A lemon-lime colour, inviting aromas of kiwi, stone fruit and lime with sweet melon, ripe pear and white pepper note. A medium bodied wine, with a concentrated palate and a long lingering and mineral finish.

The BERGSTROOM (meaning mountain stream) is named after the various deep ravines acting as a life vein for various town and is a classic blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon. This classical Bordeaux-style white blend is packed with kiwis, goosberries and green hay on the nose, whilst on the palate, the wine gives length and complexity with a well-balanced acidity to finish off this fresh wine.

**KEERMONT TERRASSE 2019
STELLENBOSCH**

590

Terrasse 2019 has a polished, light-yellow gold colour, with an explosive bouquet of lime, apple, pineapple, and peach with notes of vanilla, and butterscotch. The palate is rich, but fresh. A seemingly weightless entry comes quickly to life with ripe apricot, peach, and pear flavours complimented by cut grass, vanilla oak, and rich lees. This is followed by a lingering sweet-sour aftertaste.

**TOKARA DIRECTOR'S RESERVE

This wine displays a pale straw colour with striking brilliance that catches the light.

The nose is complex exhibiting attractive notes of ripe passion fruit and pink grapefruit all

intermingled with hints of lemon grass and freshly baked brioche. On the palate the wine

enters full and rich reminiscent of the aromas on the nose. The wine has amazing clarity

and depth with a zesty persistence.

A charming semi-sweet blend which is Muscat led (65%) with Gewürztraminer (10%) and Riesling (10%). A delicate and fruit-laden nose reveals litchi, rose petal and perfume aromas. Hints of spice follow on the medium-bodied palate. Good balance and a remarkable finish.

**FABEL MOUNTAIN VINEYARDS
JACKAL BIRD 2013**

480

Aromas of citrus blossoms and ripe honeyed melon on the nose. Apple, pear and peach are embellished by spicy oak and thrilling acidity. Good texture and weight on the mid palate with a saline minerality on the finish.





Red Wine

Pinotage

South Africa's own grape – a cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsault (Hermitage) that was created by Stellenbosch University's first Professor of Viticulture, Professor Abraham Izak Perold, in 1925. The first commercial bottling of this variety was done at Lanzerac from the 1959 vintage and the wine was released in 1961. This Pinotage was voted the best wine at the Cape Young Wine Show in 1961, leading to many producers developing some interest in making wine from this variety. When young, Pinotage wines are packed with plum and berry flavours, which then soften and develop associations with prunes, cherries and cassis, as well as red and black berries. Usually medium-to full-bodied, sometimes with a sweet sensation on the finish, and with a complexity that makes Pinotage age well for up to 10 years and more.

LANZERAC PIONIER 2020 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

488 | 1950

Lanzerac was the first commercial producer of a single varietal Pinotage and this wine honours our pioneering heritage. It delivers dense, concentrated fruit and layers of different flavours. Christmas spices of nutmeg, cloves and cinnamon surround plums, prunes, berries and currants, while the well-integrated oak and soft, silky tannins add backbone and length.

LANZERAC 2019 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

92 | 365

Matured for 16 months in French oak. Smoky soft top notes combine with black plums and sweet cherries, raspberries, prunes and hints of vanilla. Juicy, well-integrated tannins support a spicy, meaty core with a refreshing acidity and a long, smooth finish with hints of polish and leather.

L'AVENIR SINGLE BLOCK 2013 STELLENBOSCH

800

Ripe black cherries, plums, spice and chocolate are predominant on the nose, mixed with floral notes and traces of tobacco. Rich plummy fruit and complex oak flavours linger in the mouth, ending with ample soft tannins.

MEERENDAL 2021 MEERENDAL, CAPE TOWN

410

The wine has a deep, dark ruby colour with sweet fruit and some spice and dark chocolate on the nose. It displays juicy red and black berry flavours on the palate with soft tannins and has a classic dry, elegant finish.

FLAGSTONE 'WRITER'S BLOCK' 2018 BREEDEKLOOF

920

An enticing ruby red in colour. On the nose, a wonderful balancing of ripe, dark red fruit like mulberry and blackberry, with mocha chocolate and Indian spice, underpinned by a bewitching hint of bramble and mint. The palate is surprisingly rich, beautifully balanced and gives the impression of being elegant and powerful at the same time. Flavours of very ripe strawberry, cherry and darker blackberry are wrapped up in soft, comforting oak hints and a caress of vanilla and dark chocolate. Really long and luscious.

B VINTNERS 2017 STELLENBOSCH

750

Elegance, freshness and finesse are key, however still maintaining the concentration. Red and black fruits, flowers, herbs, spice and earth, giving layered complexity. The palate follows through with fruit concentration – fine, dense and structured tannin, with wonderfully fresh acidity.

RIJKS 'CELLAR SELECTION' 2017, TULBAGH

770

This deep coloured wine shows intense black berry, mulberry and slight cigar box notes on the nose. Beautiful floral tones followed by layers of red fruits. The palate is balanced between a dense core of fruit, bright acidity and fine tannins. The finish is long and pure with delicate wood spice rounding off this exceptional Pinotage.





Red Wine

Merlot

Merlot is one of the primary grapes in Bordeaux, where it is the most widely planted variety. It was introduced to the Cape winelands around 1910, although it was only from the mid-1980s that the wine 'took off' as a variety bottled on its own. It remains a popular component in the country's Bordeaux-style blends, and is grown throughout most of the winelands, though predominantly in Stellenbosch and Paarl. The wine usually appears as dark purple or blue coloured, and has a fresh and fruity taste, full of red fruits.

LANZERAC 2021 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

85 | 340

This appetising wine has concentrated black-berried fruit edged with sweet vanilla hints and spicy aromas on the nose. Savoury tannins add layers of complexity, gently supporting the flavours of plums, black cherries, cooked strawberries and dark chocolate before a long, integrated finish rounds the wine off.

BACKSBERG KOSHER 2018/2019 PAARL

450

This aromatic kosher merlot is pasteurized and prepared under supervision of the Cape Town Beth Din. This wine is Mevushal and Kosher for Passover. With Aromas of raspberry and red plum combined with successful fruit flavours and finely coated tannins ensure a pleasurable drinking experience.

VERGELEGEN 2015/2017 STELLENBOSCH

700

A ripe plum colour with a ruby rim, the nose shows ripe fruit flavours of black cherries and plums, spice and a touch of chocolate. The ripeness of the fruit is balanced by fresh fruit acidity with soft wood and fruit tannins. The aftertaste is long and lasting.

YONDER HILL ELLA 2020 STELLENBOSCH

650

The wine is well balanced and ready to enjoy with food, but will mature well in the bottle. Merlot normally loves meat and lamb and also pairs very well with tomato dishes.

MEERENDAL 2016/2020 DURBANVILLE, CAPE TOWN

910

A deep crimson colour, the nose appeals with delicate red fruit of raspberry, redcurrant and cherry, followed by rich notes of dark chocolate and almonds. The rich fruit palate is balanced by silky soft tannins, resulting in a very elegant wine. A long finish of nuts and chocolate.

SHANNON MOUNT BULLET 2016/2018 ELGIN

1 200

The wine has a fragrance of ripe red fruits such as plums and dark cherries, and a hint of olives followed by a slight leafy quality and some attractive oak-derived character. The palate has good depth of flavour and fresh acidity with earthy complexity, yet still expresses minerality. The maintained good acidity leads to outstanding freshness with a well-integrated ripe and seductive firm tannin structure making for a tight finish.





Red Wine

Shiraz / Syrah

Although some reckon that Shiraz/Syrah originated in the town of Shiraz in Iran and others argue that it came from Syracuse in Sicily, in fact the variety originated in the Rhône Valley of France. This grape delivers a wine that is probably the most exotic of all the reds, with immense concentration and complexity. It thrives in warmer climates which is why South Africa is one of the leading producers. Our full-bodied Shirazes are powerful wines, headily rich, with gamey and ripe berry fruit flavours, and considerable alcohol levels. They are multi-dimensional with layers of raspberries, blackberries and blackcurrants, full of mixed spices, leathery with dark chocolate flavours, rich and smoky oakiness, and sometimes a hint of tar.

LANZERAC 2019 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

82 | 325

This Syrah is a perfect expression of our Jonkershoek terroir, and delivers a good extraction of deep colour and aromas of white pepper, coriander, fynbos and red wine-poached plums. The complex palate shows layers of ripe red and black berries with a undertone of savouriness.

ALAIN GRILLOT CROZES-HERMITAGE 2015 RHÔNE, FRANCE

2 000

Clean, plummy and vibrant, the wine is medium-bodied and crisp, with bright fruit flavours, touches of pomegranate and a fine, velvety mouthfeel. A muscular wine with a riper fruit profile melded with savoury meatiness and a perfumed complexity.

GLEN CARLOU 2020 PAARL

550

A supple combination of black cherry and mulberry aromatics with a scent of cinnamon on an appealing nose. The velvety palate has prominent notes of blackberries, featuring spicy undertones and an integrated presence of oak. The fruit is supported by a light tannin structure, in delightful balance with the natural acidity.

HARTENBERG GRAVEL HILL 2007 STELLENBOSCH (OLD & RARE)

2 650

A dark-centred, black-red and ruby-rimmed Shiraz. Elegant black fruit with violets, cloves, smokiness and black pepper on the bouquet. The palate shows sweet ripe fruit, spicy oak and rich, dry tannins made for the long haul. The palate ends with a lingering savoury finish – all iron fist in a velvet glove.

NICOLAS VAN DER MERWE 2017 STELLENBOSCH

1 100

Sumptuously packed with red and black berries with spice aromas yet neatly refined. The palate is full-bodied but elegant with soft tannins. A dense mid-palate is full of black fruit and mocha hints with a long beeswax finish. This Syrah is more Rhône style and less blockbuster.

LEEUVENKUIL HERITAGE 2018 SWARTLAND

980

This complex Syrah is a true reflection of the Swartland area's distinctive combination of schist soils and indigenous Cape fynbos. The palate is laden with fynbos herbs, thyme, buchu and white pepper. Violet, black olive and blueberry flavours lend complexity and lead to a long, satisfying finish.

STRYDOM ROCK STAR SYRAH 2020 STELLENBOSCH

570

An elegantly styled Syrah with vibrant and harmonious layering of blackberry, white pepper and exotic spice flavours. The palate is softly textured and balanced, leading to a beautiful lingering finish.

DRIEHOEK 2019 CEDERBERG

650

An elegant Shiraz displaying flavours of cherries and blackcurrant on the nose with hints of white pepper. Beautiful oak shows delicate aromas of sweet vanilla and spice. Smooth ripe tannins leave a silky sensation on the palate.

NEIL ELLIS GROENKLOOF 2020 STELLENBOSCH

A medium-bodied Syrah with a vibrant colour. The nose has bright dark fruit with contributing perfumed aromas of violet and rose petals. Pronounced dark berry aromas with peppery notes lingering in the background while the palate is well balanced and fresh framed by fine, elegant tannins.

Shiraz / Syrah

Although some reckon that Shiraz/Syrah originated in the town of Shiraz in Iran and others argue that it came from Syracuse in Sicily, in fact the variety originated in the Rhône Valley of France. This grape delivers a wine that is probably the most exotic of all the reds, with immense concentration and complexity. It thrives in warmer climates which is why South Africa is one of the leading producers. Our full-bodied Shirazes are powerful wines, headily rich, with gamey and ripe berry fruit flavours, and considerable alcohol levels. They are multi-dimensional with layers of raspberries, blackberries and blackcurrants, full of mixed spices, leathery with dark chocolate flavours, rich and smoky oakiness, and sometimes a hint of tar.

BON COURAGE INKARA 2014 ROBERTSON

950

A complex amalgam of red-berried fruit with soft tones of chocolate and espresso. This Shiraz has a round and full mouthfeel showing mulberry, sweet spice and pepper with a silky texture and velvet character.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Described as the 'King of Grapes', Cabernet is associated with some of France's finest, with Bordeaux considered to be its home. This popular variety has been cultivated throughout the world's major wine-producing countries. It is bottled on its own but is also often blended with Cabernet Franc and/or Merlot, with some combinations also including Petit Verdot and/or Malbec. No record exists to confirm Cabernet Sauvignon's first arrival in South Africa, although it is likely that the variety has been here for over 200 years. By the 1920s it had become one of the country's top-quality red varieties and today it is grown in virtually all of the wine-producing areas. South Africa has made itself one of the go-to countries for consumers looking for a deep red wine with all the traditional flavour of a French Bordeaux. It has become a specialist at producing award-winning Cabernet Sauvignons which are prized by wine connoisseurs all over the world, yielding the familiar aromas and flavours of blackcurrant, cedarwood and lead pencil shavings, with perhaps a whiff of sweet vanilla oak. South African Cabernet is also known to show additional aromas and flavours of green pepper, mint, dark chocolate, tobacco and cloves. As it matures, it takes on the aroma of a forest floor.

LANZERAC 2018 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

A classic Cabernet. Black fruits abound with black cherries, currants and berries coming to the fore, all edged with hints of olive tapenade, dark chocolate and sun-dried tomato notes. Soft, supple tannins and freshening acidity add to the concentrated fruit.

LONGAVI 2016 MAULE VALLEY, CHILE

A wine of breathtaking intensity and richness. The nose exudes wild dark fruit aromas of blackcurrant and blackberries followed by nuances of tobacco and cedar. A ripe and well-integrated tannin structure balances with the core of black plums, liquorice and cigar box flavours, followed by some refreshing acidity. A long velvety finish.

SPRINGFIELD MÉTHODE ANCIENNE 2014 ROBERTSON (OLD & RARE)

Cabernet Franc

Cabernet Franc is one of the major red grape varieties worldwide. It is principally used for blending with Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot in the Bordeaux style but can also be found as a single varietal bottling. Cabernet Franc is one of the genetic parents of Cabernet Sauvignon although it is lighter, making bright pale red wines, and contributing finesse and a peppery perfume to blends with more robust grapes. Depending on the region and style of wine, additional aromas can include tobacco, raspberry, and cassis – sometimes even violets.

RAINBOW'S END 'SPECIAL RELEASE' 2017 STELLENBOSCH

Deep red in colour with liquorice and cherries on the nose, and ripe red fruit with hints of spice on the palate. A rich, smooth mouthfeel with a lingering finish.

CHAMONIX 2019/2020 FRANSCHHOEK

Shows a deep ruby mulberry colour and intense bouquet with scents reminiscent of bell peppers, red berries, spice and cigar box. A wine of ample structure fills the mouth with concentrated fruit and berry sensations. A good finish with a lingering aftertaste.

Pinot Noir

Pinot Noir 'took root' in the Côte d'Or in the heart of the Burgundy region in France in the 4th century AD, and in Champagne, where it is traditionally blended with Chardonnay. Of all red wines, Pinot Noir is the one that is associated with the most elegance due to its ability to combine a low tannin structure with a whole spectrum of upfront fruit flavours of raspberries, strawberries, cherries and cranberries, as well as violets and roses.

Grenache & Cinsault

GRENACHE

One of the world's most widely planted grape varieties, Grenache is a quintessentially Mediterranean red-wine variety. It originated in the northern province of Aragon, Spain, and spread to Rioja and Navarra. Grenache is also the dominant variety in most southern Rhône wines, especially Châteauneuf-du-Pape, wherein it is typically over 80% of the blend. Grenache is also used to make rosé wines in France and Spain, notably those of the Travel district in the Côtes du Rhône. Single variety Grenache wines are increasingly being produced in South Africa with success, with areas such as Piekenierskloof and Swartland being well-reputed sources for premium grapes. These wines display distinctive black pepper and spice – the cloves, nutmeg and cinnamon of a Christmas cake – with red plummy fruit.

ARENDSIG INSPIRATIONAL BATCH 2 2016/2018 ROBERTSON

An inviting fruity and floral nose of violets, red cherries and ripe plums is followed by nuances of jasmine, cinnamon and oaky leather. The palate is lively with fleshy ripe fruit that is elegantly balanced by soft waves of tannin.

NEIL ELLIS 2014/2015 PIEKENIERSKLOOF

Bright ruby red in colour. Vibrant red fruit on the nose with spicy peppery aromas that follow through to the lovely fresh palate which has great length and fine elegant tannins. A remarkably long finish.

DAVID & NADIA 2020 SWARTLAND

Rich, ripe yet tart cranberry and redcurrant fruit on the nose; raspberry strides in later. Marvellously dry on the entry, yet proactively scented and intriguing. A spicy and complex palate, with wild strawberry flavours, plenty of tannic grip, bright acidity and a long, mineral-edged finish.

CINSAULT

Comes from France, where it is spelt Cinsault, not Cinsaut. It is grown mainly in the south, from Provence to the Midi. The variety was imported from the south of France in the mid-19th century and, until the rise of Cabernet Sauvignon in the late 20th century, it was the single most widely planted red cultivar in South Africa at a time when it was better known as Hermitage. Cinsault is used chiefly as a blending component but single varietal bottlings are increasing again. It owes its popularity among farmers to its ability to withstand hot growing conditions and produces wines that have become favourites with chefs and sommeliers alike because of their pairing abilities.

NEIL ELLIS 2015 GROENEKLOOF

920

Medium in colour with a bright crimson hue, this wine portrays a complex mix of red fruits, spicy notes and perfume. Interesting complexity is gained from subtle ageing in oak. The palate is bright and youthful with cherry and fruit tart flavours. Fine grainy tannins add to the structure of the wine, leading to an elegant finish.

WATERKLOOF SERIOUSLY COOL 2019/2020

Nebbiolo & Zinfandel / Primitivo

NEBBIOLO

A native of the northwestern region of Piedmont, this variety produces some of the best quality wines in Italy. A variety that prefers cooler conditions, Nebbiolo has experienced some problems with sunburn in South African vineyards. Steenberg from Constantia has included a single varietal Nebbiolo in its portfolio since the late 1990s that is a yardstick for this variety. Wines offer a perfumed nose with plum, strawberry and fruit aromas, and upfront blackberry and dark cherry flavours. A full-flavoured, excellent food wine.

STEENBERG 2015 CONSTANTIA

740

The bouquet displays notes of rose petal, dried apricot and fynbos along with notes of leather and cherries. The palate presents the natural tart acidity and grippy tannins of Nebbiolo, accompanied by hints of sour cherries, raspberries and wild strawberries. A pleasing finish of flowers and spice.

ZINFANDEL / PRIMITIVO

Zinfandel is thought to be of European origin and is the same variety as Italy's Primitivo. However, as California's most widely planted red-wine grape at one stage, today it is synonymous with these winelands, where it has been planted since the mid-1880s. In South Africa, plantings are still small and are largely confined to Stellenbosch and Paarl, where they have been around since the 1970s. The variety is associated with rich fruitiness, and dark berry fruit and cherries are often the ones most easily identified. A nose of brambly fruit flavours can develop into a rich, spicy stew with time. Another distinctive aroma is raisins.

IDIOM 2016/2018 STELLENBOSCH

700

Silky and strong. This elegant, medium-bodied expression of Zinfandel exhibits a superb power-to-weight ratio. Aromas of red cherries and a mélange of sweet fynbos dominate the nose. An effortless entry leads to an explosive revolving tray of rosemary, raspberry, liquorice and dark chocolate flavours on the palate.

HESS SELECT 2013 CALIFORNIA, USA

1 450

Generous aromas of sweet purple plums, blackberries, blueberries and brambleberries with some underbrush as a backdrop. While this is a big Zinfandel, it is also balanced and elegant. Blackberry and black raspberry notes with a hint of vanilla on the finish.

Barbera & Sangiovese

BARBERA

Believed to have originated around Monferrato in Piedmont, Italy, Barbera is one of Italy's most widely planted red-wine grapes, often used as a blending component. Ralph Parker, third generation owner of the historic Altydgedacht estate in Durbanville, planted some in the early 1900s and Oliver, Ralph's grandson, established the wine as a regular member of the Altydgedacht range in 1986 with the maiden vintage as a single varietal wine.

ALTYDGEDACHT 2018 DURBANVILLE

A rich red colour with a nose exuding dark fruit and toasty oak aromas. The velvety entry on the palate is rounded off with varietal fruit flavours and oaky sweetness. The elegant tannin structure is a hallmark of the cooler Durbanville winegrowing region.

SANGIOVESE

From central Italy, Sangiovese is the Chianti grape par excellence, responsible in Tuscany for the famous Chianti Classico, Brunello di Montalcino and Vino Nobile di Montepulciano wines. A relative newcomer to the Cape with only a few vineyards planted, interesting single varietal wines have been made by a few producers.

IDIOM 2018 STELLENBOSCH

An enticing and emotive wine. This modern and elegant Stellenbosch Sangiovese presents a complex and tantalising nose. Initial signature sweet and sour cherry flavours develop into riper, darker fruit notes. Complex graphite, pencil shavings and vanilla notes combine with savoury spices to enhance the sweet and sour profile of Sangiovese. A silky, well balanced wine to treasure and enjoy.

Tempranillo

Tempranillo, also known as Tinta Roriz in Portugal, is the noblest red grape variety of Spain's Rioja region. The grape takes its name from the Spanish word for early, 'temprano', as it tends to ripen early. In Rioja the variety is famous for producing dark-coloured wines that are capable of ageing without losing their colour. Tempranillo is said to have arrived in the Cape with famous port varieties such as Tinta Barocca and Souzão some 50 years ago as it is especially well adapted to hot climates. Vastly used locally as a blending component in the wines of various port houses in the country, characteristic flavours include plums, blackcurrants, cassis, tea, brown sugar and vanilla.

VINA MAYOR RESERVA 2011 RIBERA DEL DUERO, SPAIN

A combination of ripe black fruit, sweet spices and delicate toasted notes with elegant hints of leather, tobacco and mocha. Rounded, silky and complex on the palate with a long, delicate finish.

BALEIA 2015 CAPE SOUTH COAST

Blackcurrant and dark cherries on the nose, complemented by leather, nuts, and sweet spices that evolve into deep savoury notes on the palate. A refreshing wine with a lingering finish.
