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# Lanzerac. The winelands at it's finest.

Introduction

Lanzerac's winemaking history started in 1914 when the owner, the formidable Mrs Elizabeth Katherina English, bottled the first Lanzerac wine from grapes grown on her land where there were believed to have been 21 imported varietals growing.

The present Lanzerac winemaking team honours the memory of this formidable lady through the Mrs English Chardonnay.

The year 1925 saw the birth of South Africa's first indigenous wine grape variety, Pinotage, which was a cross between Pinot Noir and Hermitage. In 1961, Lanzerac became the first winery in the world to use the term 'Pinotage' on their label when they marketed the 1959 vintage under the name 'Lanzerac'.

This visionary release marked the birth of Pinotage as a unique variety from South Africa. To this day, Lanzerac, under the leadership of Cellar Master Wynand Lategan and viticulturist Michael Roets, is still producing award-winning Pinotage wines along with a wide variety of other cultivars of excellent quality.

Cap Classique is the term that describes the South African bottle-fermented sparkling wines produced in the French Méthode Champenoise style, whereby the second fermentation has to take place in the bottle that the wine will be served from. The name was derived from the fact that the classic art of winemaking was introduced to the Cape by the French Huguenots. The first bottle-fermented sparkling wine, called Kaapse Vonkel (Cape Sparkle), was produced in South Africa in 1971. Pinot Noir and Chardonnay are commonly used to make the premium styles of these wines, but other varieties like Sauvignon Blanc and Chenin Blanc are also extensively used. These sparkling wines are perfect for celebrations!

#### LANZERAC BLANC DE BLANCS BRUT NV JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

#### 90 | 440

With this fine Cap Classique, everyday becomes a celebration. Creamy, biscuit notes gives texture to the lively citrus and apple aromas whilst the tiny bubbles are like beads of sunshine dancing on your tongue. An elegant and refined Cap Classique with the mousse showing finesse and texture.

### VILLIERA TRADITION BRUT NV STELLENBOSCH

#### 400

This Cap Classique is a blend of red and white grapes displaying the full, balanced yeasty complexity synonymous with a wine made in this style. The wine retains its fresh racy zestiness that is a result of crisp acidity and rich fruit.

#### VILLIERA TRADITION BRUT ROSÉ NV STELLENBOSCH

#### 400

A skilful blend of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinotage and Pinot Meunier. Joyful, rich pink colour with elegant bubbles is elegant and fresh with hints of strawberry and yeastiness along with fine mousse. Flavourful with a long finish.

## COLMANT DELICE NECTAR NV FRANSCHHOEK

#### 875

Elegantly luscious yet still classic, this blend offers an exotic twist to the colmant style. A slightly off-dry wine with lingering flavours of ripe citrus and sun-sweetened apple generosity.

#### CHARLES FOX BRUT ROSÉ 2020 FI GIN

#### 720

Rose gold, Salmon pink hues, gleaming with fine consintant bubbles. the palate is marked by fresh red fruits, red current blueberry & raspberry and a hint of strawberries. pure beautiful and delicate first taste, well balanced and generouse palate.

#### GRAHAM BECK BRUT ZERO 2017 ROBERTSON

#### 990

Ultra Brut is the quintessence of the Graham Beck style. With a viridescent hue, this Cap Classique opens up with a lively bouquet of lemon zest and brioche notes. The rich, complex palate is perfectly balanced by fresh acidity and an exceptionally refined mousse - a benchmark of the 2017 vintage. Endowed with a deliciously creamy texture and a rewarding finish, this ultra-dry sparkling wine is ideal to drink now or in the next 5 or 8 years.

#### BON COURAGE JACQUES BRUÉRE BRUT RESERVE 2014 ROBERTSON

#### 620

It expresses both intensity and delicacy. Toasted nutty characters infused with stone fruits complimented by rich, creamy biscuit flavours. Lingering finish with a lively mousse.

#### STEENBERG 'LADY R' 2016 WESTERN CAPE

#### 1 290

The Steenberg Lady R Cap Classique shimmers in a light copper hue in the glass and immediately inspires with its aromatic fragrance. The bouquet reveals wonderful notes of raspberries and red apples. The fruity nuances are underpinned by almonds, coconut and dried herbs. Creamy and soft, the sparkling wine caresses the palate, while a fresh acidity and mineral tones surround the subtle aromas of pears and cinnamon. The fine perlage and good structure give the Steenberg Lady R Cap Classique its elegance. The sparkling wine underwent the second fermentation in the bottle and then lay on the yeast for another 52 months. Enjoy the fine bubbly cuvée of Pinot Noir (70%) and Chardonnay (30%) best pure as an aperitif on festive occasions or serve the sparkling wine with light dishes.





Champagne, a sparkling wine produced in the Champagne region of France and primarily made from Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes, must be made in the Méthode Traditionnelle, meaning the second fermentation process must take place in the same bottle that it is served from. The history of the invention of sparkling wine sparks debate as the French Benedictine monk (Dom Perignon) is often and erroneously credited with having invented sparkling wine in 1697. Records, however, have shown that an English physician, Christopher Merret, had documented attempts to intentionally create a sparkling wine long before Perignon. It is clear, however, that the French played the most important role in perfecting the art of making sparkling wine.

#### LAURENT PERRIER ROSÉ NV CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

#### 3 500

An elegant raspberry-coloured bubbly in an iconic pink bottle. Lively and well-rounded, combining elegant red fruit, structure and freshness.

#### LOUIS ROEDERER CRISTAL BRUT MILLÉSIMÉ 2013/14 CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

#### 15 500

A golden hue with soft, glowing highlights. Fine, steady, gentle bubbles. Powerful and complex on the palate, revealing a mixture of yellow fruit (Mirabelle plum), juicy, ripe fruits (nectarine), citrus peel (candied orange) and finelyroasted nuts (hazelnut). The nose is simultaneously powdery and sweet, with elegant, chalky notes. Gentle, tactile and full-bodied on the palate. The bubbles create a gentle, vibrating sensation, then the wine becomes soft, dense and juicy. But it is the chalky freshness that quickly sets the tone: the sweetness becomes energetic and intense, giving the wine an elegant yet powerful texture. Fine, textured tannins reveal a poised and vinous dimension to the wine. The finish is savoury and saline.

#### LOUIS ROEDERER COLLECTION, 243 CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

#### 2990

Bright, golden hue with shimmering highlights. Fine, lively mousse with lingering threads of bubbles. The bouquet is open and rich yet also wonderfully fresh. It offers an explosion of ripe, delicate fruit with intense notes of yellow fruit (Mirabelle plum) from the Pinot noir complemented by sweet citrus fruits (lemon meringue pie) and delicate notes of white flowers (jasmine) from the Chardonnay. The nose opens up to reveal autolytic characters and evolves towards smoky, roasted notes and freshly baked pastries.

#### DOM PERIGNON BRUT 2013 CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

#### 10 100

The creation of the 2013 vintage reveals the resonance between the pinots noirs and chardonnays, between acidity and fullbodied. The precise, elegant and tactile bouquet blooms in an extremely delicate powdery aromatic braid around three nuances: first citrus, then a more vegetal facet and lastly, spices. This precision reveals a simple and evident elegance where the wine, after an ethereal attack, amplifies and blossoms before ceding to an ineffable sensation of clarity.

#### PHILIPPONANT ROYAL RESERVE NON-DOSE NV CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

#### 2 500

Pale gold in colour. Delicate, lingering froth with aromas of linden, vine blossom and hawthorn, the palate is bold and pure, with notes of citrus fruit and great liveliness without aggressiveness. The finish is long and clear with notes of warm bread and fresh apple.





#### CAVA

This is a Spanish bottle-fermented sparkling wine. Cava is typically made from Spanish indigenous grape varieties, namely Macabeo, Parellada and Xarello. The production of Cava was adopted by the Spanish from the French in the late 19th Century when Joseph Ravento of the Codorníu Winery in Catalonia visited Champagne and returned to make Cava in 1872. Like many traditional sparkling wines, Cava is made in a range of styles from very dry and off-dry, to sweeter.

#### CODORNIU CUVEE CLASSICO BRUT ORGANIC NV CATALONIA, SPAIN

#### 910

The wine showcases, fruity aromas typical of traditional cava varieties predominate. Lemon, yellow apple and melon. while the palate is pleasant, fresh and, balanced.

#### **PROSECCO**

A sparkling wine from the great winegrowing region of Veneto in Italy. The grape variety that is essential for the production of Prosecco is called Glera, although small amounts of other varieties such as Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Grigio may be blended with it. Unlike Champagne or Cap Classique that are made using the Traditional Method, Prosecco is mainly produced using the Transfer Method (Charmat), where the second fermentation happens in pressurised stainless steel vessels. This method produces wines with a fruity and floral nose.

#### VALDO ORO PURO VALDOBBIADENE SUPERIORE DOCG BRUT NV VENETO, ITALY

#### 1230

This Superior Prosecco comes from the UNESCO world heritage site of Valdobbiadene, with Aromas of golden apple & honey on the nose follow through to a delicate palate of fine bubbles. The Valdo Prosecco Superiore has an elegant palate with a creamy finish.

#### DA LUCA BRUT NV VENETO, ITALY

#### 420

A really refreshing low-alcohol sparkler with appealing floral, citrus and stone fruit aromas. The palate is fresh and flavoursome, displaying characters of peach, apple and capsicum, with a touch of sweetness and a clean, crisp finish.



## Rosé & Blanc de Noir



These are pink wines, usually light-bodied and made by incorporating the colour of red grape skins to white juice. It is essential to understand that many red-wine grape varieties have white juice and the colour of red wines comes from the period of skin contact after crushing. There are three major ways of making rosé wine, namely short skin contact, bleeding off, and blending of red and white wine. It may be the oldest known type of wine as it is the most straightforward to make, especially using the skin contact method. The pink colours can range from a pale 'onion skin' orange to a vivid near-purple, depending on the varieties and winemaking techniques used. Fresh, fruity, light rosé wines are perfect for summer.

#### LANZERAC PINOTAGE ROSÉ 2023 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

#### 50 | 200

Made from 100% Pinotage grapes. Gentle aromatic tones of perfume and rose petals are followed by nuances of crushed strawberries and redcurrants. This wine is excellent with our selection of salads – not too dry, not too sweet, just right.

#### DELAIR GRAFF CABERNET FRANC ROSÉ 2023 STELLENBOSCH

#### 360

Made from 100% Cabernet Franc grapes, this exceptional rosé displays flavours of freshly crushed berries and candyfloss with a slightly minty nose. With a richly textured palate and crisp, balanced acidity, it presents a full dry finish.

#### FABLE MOUNTAIN VINEYARDS BELLE FLOWER ROSÉ 2019 TULBAGH

#### 320

The colour is bright, pale pink with salmon hues like the Rosé you will find in the Provence. The nose is beautifully layered and complex with wild strawberries, rose petals and hints of mandarin orange and citrus blooms. Strawberries carry through on the palate accompanied with honeydew melon and baking spices like nutmeg and cardamom with subtle hints of dill and stone minerality. The finish is long with soft creamy layered flavours and mineral and fresh lingering acidity.

#### BOSCHENDAL PINOT NOIR CHARDONAY 2023 COASTAL REGION

#### 290

Exceptional wine-making yields an incredible sophisticated crisp, pale blush wine with outstanding finesse and elegance. Hints of strawberry preserve impart an intriguing aroma, characteristic hints of ripe red berries are also evident. A truly versatile wine.



## Rosé & Blanc de Noir

Blanc de Noir

This is a method of making white wine from red grapes and it is called 'blanc de noir' (meaning 'white from black'), more famously used in Champagne production in France, where whole-bunch pressing is used to prevent the juice from obtaining colour from the skins.

#### PETER FALKE BLANC DE NOIR 2022 STELLENBOSCH

**370** 

Made solely from Cabernet Sauvignon, this wine gives you hues of delicate blush pink coulor, with subtle aromas of crushed strawberries, ripe nectarines and flower petals. The palate finishes with a freshness of pomegranates and a stylish silkiness.





Sauvignon Blanc

The origins of this green-skinned grape are the famous Loire Valley and Bordeaux regions in France. Sauvignon Blanc is planted in many of the world's wine regions, producing aromatic, crisp, dry and refreshing white wines. The grape is also a component of the famous dessert wines from Sauternes and Barsac. Some new world Sauvignons are aged in wood. Popular examples are from California and they are called 'fumé blanc', a marketing term given by the Americans in reference to Pouilly-Fumé from the Loire Valley in France. South Africa produces premium wines of this variety in both wooded and unwooded styles, the best ones coming from the cooler, coastal regions.

#### LANZERAC 2023 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

#### 50 | 200

This crisp and refreshing Sauvignon Blanc boasts generous aromas of green fruits including Granny Smith apples that interplay with white fruits such as Asian pears and white peaches in a perfect fruitacid balance. A fresh lemongrass mouthfeel with subtle minerality is rounded off by a soft creaminess in the long finish due to extended lees contact.

#### CLOUDY BAY 2022 MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

#### 2 412

Fresh citrus and nettle aromas fill the nose. The palate is concentrated and full bodied with a rich peppery and mineral mouthfeel.

#### DOMAIN DELAPORTE SANCERRE CHAVIGNOL BLANC SILEX 2021 SANCERRE

#### 1608

Pale gold with green hints. Very expressive, intense and complex nose with boxwood, rhubarb, blackcurrant, kiwi fragrances and a light vegetal touch (marigold). The entry is soft and round. Bright freshness on the palate, delicate and lively purity. Well balanced and harmonious, it ends with a clean lingering finish

#### REYNEKE (CERTIFIED ORGANIC & BIODYNAMIC) 2022 STELLENBOSCH

#### 580

This Sauvignon Blanc is bursting with vibrant aromas of lime, gooseberries, and green guava, with underlying hints of grapefruit, lemon, and flint. On the palate, it exhibits a lovely brightness, with distinct notes of fresh lime and lemon pith. The wine also boasts additional complexity, which adds to its length and leaves a lasting impression the finish.

#### KLEIN CONSTATIA METIS 2019 CONSTANTIA

#### 660

Lively and bright in appearance. The nose bursts with aromas of blackcurrant leaf, wet slate and limes. Rich complex flavours of kiwi fruit and lemon zest follow on the palate. Textured with a coarse salinity on the mid palate. A pure expression of Sauvignon Blanc. Youthful and elegant, the wine concludes with a long zesty lingering finish.

#### DE GRENDEL KOETSHUIS 2022 DURBANVILLE

#### **520**

This wine leans more towards a fuller and richer style, with intense hints of minerality, gooseberries and a herbaceous nose and palate. Supported by a fresh acidity this wine is a full-bodied white wine with an exceptionally long finish.

#### DAVID NIEUWOUDT 'GHOST CORNER' 2022 ELIM

#### 640

An explosive nose of green nettles, green asparagus and pink grape-fruit citrus with some dusty fig leaf and blackcurrant aromas creates excitement anticipation of what is to follow. The palate does not disappoint – a delicious carry through of the expressive nose creates a broad, flavour-intensive palate, ending with a lemon zest mouthwatering finish. The influence of the Cape Agulhas terroir is apparent in the salty/briny final lingering aftertaste.

#### ANTHONIJ RUPERT CAPE OF GOOD HOPE 'ALTIMA' 2024 ELANDSKLOOF

#### 390

Appealingly bold aromas of tropical fruits-guava, kiwi, and fig-highlighted by a light grapefruit sheen. Taut, crisp, and tangy, the palate boasts an abundance of citrus vivacity. The ripe tropical notes from the nose are present as well, with kiwi and fig complemented by a light dusting of flint and white pepper for added complexity. Texture is impressive, with a leesy breadth and length that define its character. The balance and harmony of fruit, acid, and lees are notable, and the finish is remarkably lingering.





Sanvignon Blanc

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#### SPRINGFIELD LIFE FROM STONE 2024 ROBERTSON

#### 390

From old vines grown on stony soils. This South African classic is fresh yet gives herbaceous notes married with flinty, black powder on the nose followed by a mineral palate. Quince on the finish.

#### KLEINE ZALZE FAMILY RESERVE 2021 WESTERN CAPE

#### 860

Lively and herbaceous with crisp layers of fruit. Intense palate with tropical and green elements. A serious wine with a long future. Will reward careful cellaring for the next 5 years.

#### FRYER'S COVE BAMBOES BAY 2022 BAMBOES BAY

#### 844

A vibrant mix of clean herbaceous and tangy passion fruit aromas, with wisps of intense fresh seaweed and gravelly crunch in the background. The palate shows a full lingering powerful combination of ripe Citrus, Stone fruit and Lemon Grass. The elegance it shows is backed by a succulent acid framework and subtle minerality.

#### IONA 2024 ELGIN

#### 415

The 2024 cool climate Elgin Highlands Sauvignon Blanc is vibrant, mineral, elegant, balanced and delicate, with a long, layered and complex finish.





Undoubtedly one of the greatest white grape varieties of the world, Chardonnay originates from Burgundy in France and some of the best examples are found here. Cultivated in every wine producing country and made in a range of styles; from the lean and austere wines of Chablis to the creamy, wooded and full-bodied ones of Mâconnais. Chardonnay is also known for its important role in the production of Champagne and the other premium sparkling wines of the world. South Africa is one of the new world countries known for producing premium Chardonnay, with the Walker Bay region around the small coastal town of Hermanus getting increased recognition all over the world for this variety.

#### LANZERAC MRS ENGLISH 2023 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

#### 225 | 900

Subtle and elegant with a steely core, this wine perfectly mirrors its illustrious namesake in every way. This is a complex wine with an abundance of citrus flavours on the nose, a full palate and lingering aftertaste. Careful oak and extended lees contact have added texture and richness, leaving the wine seamless, subtle and satisfying.

#### LANZERAC 2022/23 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

#### 77 | 305

A spicy fruit bomb with lashings of ginger biscuit aromas overlaying soft cooked apples with caramel and cream, this is a wine which is jampacked with flavour. A soft, buttery mouthful of tropical fruits such as mangoes, pineapples and bananas edged with toasty oak is balanced by good acidity. Finishes with a toee-cream tail.

#### ALBERT BICHOT CRU 'LES LYS' DOMAIN LONG-DEPAQUIT 2021 CHABLIS, FRANCE

#### 2 136

The nose boasts distinct notes of white flowers ("Lys" is French for lily) and citrus fruit. The palate is elegant and finely chiselled with a discreet marine note that is typical of the Chablis appellation. Beautiful, long-lasting finish with a fleeting tinge of acidity.

#### JOURNEYS END 'DESTINATION' 2022 STELLENBOSCH

#### 670

The 2022 nose is complex and delivers concentrated stone fruit with layers of citrus, lemongrass, tropical fruit, and hints of smoky spice attributed to generous oak aging. The ever present natural minerality and acidity ensure freshness and adds focus to a long-lasting creamy finish. The Destination is our interpretation of the great Chardonnays of Mersault and this particularly racy vintage will reward patient cellaring for up to 10 years from vintage.

### PAUL CLUVER 2020/23 ELGIN

#### 680

On the nose, this wine shows great citrus character with ripe orange and winter melon notes, against lightly toasted brioche. Tangerine fruit and citrus blossom fragrances are apparent, with hints of vanilla pod and a slight salinity. These characteristics follow through onto the palate. The fine, fresh acidity is natural, and adds poise and focus to the wine.

#### ATARAXIA 2023 HEMEL-EN-AARDE

#### 810

This soil-driven Chardonnay is New World in provenance but Old World in stylistic leaning. Athletic in structure, it effortlessly manages to be both subtle and intense. It is vibrant and spicy, with alluring creamy notes. An assertive mineral acidity beautifully balances a compelling intensity of fruit. There is a surprising touch of "grip" to the finish deftly rounded off with complex savoury, briny, and flinty notes. A stylish, world-class Chardonnay.





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#### BOSCHKLOOF 2023 WESTERN CAPE

#### 346

A wine created in a complex but fresh style with citrus, lime, and hints of apricot flavours. Elegant aroma shows citrus characters, integrated with subtle hints of oak that adds dimension to the palate. Good fruit and balance with long lingering finish. Enjoy now or benefit from cellaring.

#### CREATION 2023 WALKER BAY

#### 510

A chic chardonnay with Glorious layers of Sunkissed pear and peach enhanced by fresh minerality and hints of spice.

#### RHEBOKSKLOOF 2021/22 PAARL

#### 450

This wine is a beautiful medley of flavours with red grapefruit and juicy ripe nartjie dominant at first, developing into an appealing lemon meringue texture and flavour complemented by hints of vanilla pod. The wine has a long finish with prominent orange blossoms and potpourri notes.

### CHAMONIX WOODED 2021 FRANSCHHOEK

#### 490

This elegant wine is complex with citrus and pear notes that is complemented by an intriguing nuttiness and a crisp finish. The Chamonix Chardonnay can mature in the bottle for many years.

#### EIKENDAL JANINA UNWOODED 2023 COASTAL REGION

#### 330

Flavours of green apple, lemon and fresh pineapple. Nuances of honey and orange blossoms develop on the palate and carry through to a delightful, fresh, flinty and lingering finish.

#### GLENELLY GLASS COLLECTION 2021 STELLENBOSCH

#### 308

This Chardonnay has bright and brilliant colour with a slight green hue. The wine has complex aromas of citrus, lychee and pear. On the palate, there is a beautiful round comforting texture with wonderful length and intense fruit complexity and a zesty lime and lemon notes.





Chenin Blanc is a white grape that has a very long history as it is thought to have been established in Anjou, in the Loire Valley region of France, as far back as the ninth century. It has also played a big role in the intriguing history of winemaking in South Africa, as it is believed to have been among the first vine cuttings that arrived here in 1655 during the time of Governor Jan van Riebeeck. Chenin Blanc is currently the most planted variety in South Africa because of its important role in the production of local brandy, as well as its versatility in wine production as it is made in a wide range of styles, from premium dry table wines to high quality sweet dessert wines. While most South African Chenin Blanc wines are still made in a fresh and fruity style, that is changing. More and more producers are focusing on mature bush vines and wooded styles that have given the nation a significant point of difference as we have really old Chenin vines, resulting in concentrated, full-bodied, food-friendly wines that are taking the world by storm.

#### MARC BRÉDIF VOUVRAY 2021 LOIRE, FRANCE

#### 860

The Vouvray Chenin Blanc is a beautiful crystalline pale yellow. A fine nose reminiscent of well-ripe yellow fruits (peach and pear), to which are added notes of exotic fruits such as pineapple and shades of citrus. The attack is full and rich, with a lot of volume, evolving on a lemony freshness and long and lively exotic fruit finish.

#### KAAPZICHT KLIPRUG 2023 STELLENBOSCH

#### 470

Rich, deep, complex nose of bruised yellow fruits, white peach, creamy and plush, showing honeyed pineapples and leesy yellow fruits. Plenty of gravitas, fruit weight, focus and textural complexity.

#### KEN FORRESTER OLD VINE RESERVE 2023 STELLENBOSCH

#### 420

This wine is a great example of the harmonious balance which can be achieved between fruit and delicate oak/vanilla flavours, as they combine to form complex, soft flavours with sufficient body to enhance even spicy and full flavoured meals.

#### KEERMONT 'RIVERSIDE' 2019 STELLENBOSCH

#### 990

Riverside Chenin Blanc 2019 has a light, gold colour with a green hue. It has a bouquet of citrus blossom and apricot, with hints of cut grass, oyster shell and vanilla. The entry on the palate is soft and light at first, but then opens up with pure fruit flavours of ripe peach and apple and a touch of marzipan and vanilla. Lovely zippy acidity allows for a long, clean, textured finish with a lingering aftertaste of rich fruit and butterscotch. Drink 2022-2032.

#### BEAUMONT FAMILY WINES 2024 BOT RIVIER

#### 360

This is a fruit-filled unwooded Chenin Blanc. The 2024 vintage produced very healthy grapes full of flavour and great intensity. It is a delicious example of cooler climate Chenin Blanc fermented in concrete and stainless steel tanks using a combination of cultured and natural yeasts. Matured after fermentation on the lees to add some extra weight and complexity to the wine.

#### AA BADENHORST SECATEURS 2023/24 SWARTLAND

#### 320

The aromas are flinty with honey, orange blossom with some notes of tropical fruit, yellow apple and ripe pear. The palate is fresh and zesty with fruity flavours following through from the nose. A mineral finish.





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#### AVONDALE ANIMA BIODYNAMIC (CERTIFIED ORGANIC & BIODYNAMIC) 2019 PAARL

#### 800

Anima has a nose that develops intriguingly in the glass. Winter melon, pineapple, lime and a hint of honey confirm the elegance and fullness of this softly wooded, supple Chenin Blanc. The palate is dense with fresh fruit flavours of gooseberry, quince and peach, all harmonising superbly with the soulful minerality that gives this wine its name.

#### LONGRIDGE 2023 STELLENBOSCH (CERTIFIED ORGANIC)

410

A fresh wine with a lovely hue, bursting with aromas of ripe guava, pineapple, kiwi, green apple and a hint of strawberry, ending with a well-balanced acidity and a lingering finish.





Riesling is an aromatic white grape variety that originated in the Rhine region of Germany. It is one of the most interesting grape varieties of the world, displaying flowery, almost perfumed, aromas as well as a high acidity. Riesling is made in a wide range of styles, from dry to semi-sweet, sweet and sparkling white wines. These wines are usually varietally pure and are seldom oaked. The cooler climate areas of South Africa have recently been very successful in making premium styles of this variety with producers from the Elgin region in particular getting increased recognition for their wines.

#### REICHSGRAF VON KESSELSTATT 2018/20 WILTINGER, MOSEL GERMANY

#### 910

Whiffs of freesia and tangerine peel waft from this semi-dry Riesling. It is low in alcohol yet so honeyed and ripe that flavours of grapefruit and peach seem to slick sumptuously on the palate. A zesty lime acidity freshens a lingering finish.

#### HARTENBERG DRY RIESLING 2020/21 STELLENBOSCH

#### 400

Winsome aromas of quince, ripe melon, roses and frangipani on the nose. The palate displays layers upon layers of citrus, peaches and honey balanced by a flinty, crisp acidity that lingers.

#### DE WETSHOF 2017 ROBERTSON

#### 540

The nose is filled with soft stone fruit and a smell of sweet turpentine that is distinctive and very pleasant. The palate is crisp and delicate with wonderful bright fruit of white-fleshed peach. Finishes off with fruity acidity and brilliant minerality.

### CATHERINE MARSHALL 2023 FI GIN

#### 360

Exudes sweet yet persistent, bright, fresh limes, crisp apple, bees wax and wild honey. The fresh acidity provides tension on the core that is well balanced with the fruit sweetness and a marked vibrancy of citrus on the finish.

## PAUL CLUVER VILAGE 2023 ELGIN

#### 330

The wine is pale in colour, with a beautiful green tint. This is an expressive wine with a melody of fresh fruit and citrus blossom notes. The palate is delicate with elegantly clean and zesty lime notes with great textural feel of the mid palate. There is a great interplay between the naturally retained residual sugar and acidity. Generally regarded as restrained, it displays typical Riesling 'nervousness'. The mineral core, which is linked to the shale rich soils in which the vines grow, adds great complexity, structure and the lingering after taste.





Pinot Blanc & Gewürztraminer

#### **PINOT BLANC**

Much uncertainty surrounds the early history of this variety as to whether it is a genetic mutation of Pinot Noir or related to Chardonnay as its old name Pinot Chardonnay may suggest. For many years Pinot Blanc and Chardonnay were mistaken for each other, as this grape produces wines that are very similar to and usually blended with Chardonnay.

#### KELDERMEESTER VERSAMELING BERGPAD 2023 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

#### 510

Exclusively made by our cellarmaster from a single vineyard on the Jonkershoek Mountain overlooking the Lanzerac facilities. Bergpad is a complex wine with an interplay of stone fruit and white floral notes. on the nose is preserved quince, violets, lavender and pears which follow through on the palate, where creaminess and softness enter at the mid-palate and linger on the extended finish.

#### **GEWÜRZTRAMINER**

Gewürztraminer is, without a doubt, the most distinctively aromatic of all the white grapes. Its origins come from the Traminer variety, a green-skinned grape that takes its name from the village of Tramin, located in South Tyrol, the German-speaking province in northern Italy. It was spread to Alsace, where gewürz (spice) was added to its name. This variety produces an exotic, spicy, perfumed wine that has flavours of litchis and seems full-bodied, even if it isn't. It performs best in cooler climates.

#### NEETHLINGSHOF 2023 STELLENBOSCH

#### 250

Pale lemon in colour with pronounced aromas of litchi, ripe yellow apples, rose petals and hints of Turkish delight finishing off with hints of marmalade on the palate.





Pinot Gris / Pinot Grigio & Viognier

#### **PINOT GRIS AND PINOT GRIGIO**

Pinot Gris and Pinot Grigio are in fact the exact same grape variety but the names have come to infer two different styles of wine. The immensely popular Italian-style (Pinot Grigio) wines are typically lighter-bodied, crisp and fresh with vibrant stone fruit and floral aromas, and a touch of spice. In contrast, the French Pinot Gris wines from the region of Alsace are more full-bodied, richer, spicier and more viscous in texture. They also tend to have greater cellaring and ageing potential. In South Africa Pinot Gris/Grigio is mostly made in a dry style.

#### IDIOM BIANCO 2022 STELLENBOSCH

#### 350

Light straw in colour with citrus zest, acacia flowers and hints of flinty minerality on the nose. Elegant mouthfeel with flavours of white pear and green apple. This refreshing wine with a well-structured, mid-palate showcases the great potential of Pinot Grigio from South Africa.

#### USANA 2022 STELLENBOSCH

#### 330

Crisp and refreshing, this Pinot Gris displays hints of green apple, pear and sweet honeydew melon, and a fresh, flinty edge. A smooth, subtly silk-like overtone leaves a distinctive impression on the palate. A refreshing finish.

#### **VIOGNIER**

Viognier's home is in France's northern Rhône appellations of Condrieu and Côte-Rôtie. However, it is thought to have originated in Dalmatia (Bosnia) and was imported into France around 280 AD. An early ripener and very hard to grow even in perfect conditions, it has an exuberant character that is generously perfumed and opulent but dry. In spite of lower levels of acidity, it is full-bodied with seductive flavours of apricot, peach, musk and lime blossoms.

## TAMBOERSKLOOF 2023 STELLENBOSCH

#### **500**

A light golden wine with aromas of tangerine, orange blossom and rose following through with peaches to the palate. The palate offers additional spices and apricot, along with texture which creates a lingering finish.

## LISMORE AGE OF GRACE 2021 GRAYTON

#### **526**

This expressive viognier seduces you with the beautiful perfume of honeysuckle and orange blossom and a textured palate of apricot, kiwi and pineapple. A sensual and exotic experience. Barrel fermented and aged. Enjoy it now or allow it to gain complexity with further cellaring.





#### **SEMILLON**

The Semillon grape is native to the Bordeaux region of France. A variety that produces wines considered to be perfectly food-friendly, it is appreciated for its rounded, lanolin-like quality with honey and citrus tones that are only enhanced by oak ageing. Grown mainly in the cooler regions of South Africa, these wines are usually blended with Sauvignon Blanc to add body and structure. As a single varietal wine, Semillon often displays herbaceous, grassy flavours when young but with age this wine becomes rich, luscious, even more lanolintextured, and increasingly honeyed and toasty.

#### DAVID NIEUWOUDT GHOST CORNER 2023 ELIM

#### 490

The wine displays a pale straw hue with a nose that opens up to a youthful expression of lemon/lime citrus and subtle hints of crushed pineapple, green melon and a touch of fig leaf dustiness. The wine reveals viscosity and texture on the palate due to lees contact, balancing the palate weight with a refreshingly crisp green apple finish. Best enjoyed after a year or two in the bottle to allow the wine to achieve its full expression and poise.

#### RICKERTY BRIDGE PAULINA'S RESERVE 2021/22 FRANSCHHOEK

#### 449

Lime and apple aromas layered with nuances of honeyed beeswax. The rich elegant palate of honey and citrus is perfectly balanced with well-integrated oak notes, minerality and a delightful lingering creamy finish.

#### **VERDELHO**

A Portuguese variety popularly known for its contribution to the famous fortified wines of the Madeira Islands, there are very few plantings of this variety in South Africa and the grapes are usually destined for a few blended table wines. Only a few winemakers are producing single varietal Verdelho wines with success.

#### STELLENBOSCH VINEYARDS 2020 STELLENBOSCH

#### 560

Made utilising wild yeast, barrel fermented and from a single vineyard, this is an exceptional wine revealing peach and apricot aromas with flinty, floral and nutty nuances. Its zesty nature makes this a complex wine showing raw almond and dried fruit on the palate. Its well-integrated acid line contributes to the refreshing, lingering finish.





Grenache Blanc & Doussanne

#### **GRENACHE BLANC**

Grenache Blanc (Garnacha Blanca) is a white grape variety that is related to the red grape Grenache Noir. It originated in northern Spain but is also found in the Rhône region of France. It is an important variety in the Rhône Valley, where it is often blended with Roussanne in the famous white wines of Châteauneuf-du-Pape.

### THE FOUNDRY 2020/21 VOOR PAARDEBERG

#### 610

Lifted floral aromas with hints of lemon cream and white stone fruit. The palate is rich but restrained with focused, pure fruit, a minerally mid-palate with a characteristic rich, fleshy mouthfeel and texture, and a long finish with a citrus tang.

#### **ROUSSANNE**

Roussanne is a white Rhône variety that gets its name from the russet tone (roux) of its skin. Together with Marsanne, with which it is often blended, Roussanne is one of only two cultivars permitted in the white versions of the northern Rhône red-wine appellations of Hermitage, Crozes-Hermitage and Saint-Joseph, and in the exclusively white, often sparkling Saint-Péray. In the southern Rhône, Roussanne is one of four varieties allowed in white Châteauneuf-du-Pape. As a varietal wine or blending component, the variety remains a tiny factor in the Cape's vineyards.

#### KEN FORRESTER RESERVE 2022 STELLENBOSCH

#### 780

Medium yellow with golden hues, and a huge and complex nose with dominat green figs, confit orange, marzipan and nutmeg. Luxurious oak notes upfront of a fully round mouthfeel coat the palate with lime, fig and buttered brioche toast. Elegant, rich restrained, hints of lime blossom, soft on the palate with a gentle structure, yet remains fresh with a chalky saline acid frame. An impressive long finish.





#### **BUKETTRAUBE**

Thought to be German, although there is a variety in Alsace, France, called Bouquettraube, which is said to have originated in Würzburg ('Buket' is German for bouquet). Still grown in Alsace on a small scale, Bukettraube has not been a great traveller. First imported to South Africa in 1967, the variety adapted well. South Africa appears to be the only country outside Germany and France to have any plantings and bottles it as a single varietal wine.

#### CEDERBERG 2023 CEDERBERG

#### 320

A perfumed nose of peach and white blossoms with subtle hints of muscat and dried apricots. Rich, opulent, mouth-coating flavours on the palate wrap your senses in exotic tastes delivering delicate sweetness and ending in a clean, lingering finish.

#### **SYLVANER**

Sylvaner is the French name for the German variety known as Silvaner, although it is said to have originated in Austria. Wine from this grape has a naturally high acid level. It is still popular in areas in Germany where Riesling struggles to ripen as it ripens two weeks earlier.

#### OVERGAAUW 2020 STELLENBOSCH

#### 350

The only single-varietal Sylvaner produced in South Africa, this wine is refreshing and medium-bodied with aromas of pear, apricot and white-fleshed peach, and small traces of floral and spice notes. The fruit follows through onto the palate with a pleasingly crisp, lingering finish.





Grüner Veltliner, Chenel & Vermentino

#### **GRÜNER VELTLINER**

The most important grape variety in Austria, Grüner Veltliner achieved worldwide awareness and popularity at the end of the last century. It is a fertile variety and therefore requires yield regulation. It grows especially well in deep soil, does not like dryness and is sensitive during flowering.

#### DIEMERSDAL 2022 DURBANVILLE

#### 300

A lemon-lime colour, inviting aromas of kiwi, stone fruit and lime with sweet melon, ripe pear and white pepper note. A medium bodied wine, with a concentrated palate and a long lingering and mineral finish.

#### **CHENEL**

Chenel is a white-wine grape variety that was developed in South Africa's Western Cape in 1974. It is a crossing of Chenin Blanc and Ugni Blanc (Trebbiano), and was bred specifically for its resistance to disease and rot. Chenel has inherited a high level of acidity from its parents, which may be used to produce crisp varietal wines, or as an anonymous blending agent.

### SPRINGFONTEIN 2021 SPRINGFONTEIN RIM

#### 980

This Chenel is true to the terroir characterized by cool climate and limestone soils. It has apple and peach notes on the nose, minerality and soft acidity on the palate. The oak aromas are well integrated and very subtle on the taste.

#### **VERMENTINO**

Vermentino is a white-wine grape grown in various locations around the western Mediterranean: northwestern Italy, southern France and the neighboring islands of Corsica and Sardinia.

#### BACCO 2023 SIMONSBERG-PAARL

#### **395**

This Italian cultivar is a rare find in South Africa, but it's certainly a wine that exudes the flair of our Tuscan heritage. Exotic aromas and tastes abound from daffodil and sea spray to stone fruit and mineral inflections. A soft touch of oak adds complexity.





#### KELDERMEESTER VERSAMELING BERGSTROOM 2022

#### **CAPE COAST**

#### 510

The BERGSTROOM (meaning mountain stream) is named after the various deep ravines acting as a life vain for various town and is a classic blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon. This classical Bordeaux-style white blend is packed with kiwis, goosberries and green hay on the nose, whilst on the palate, the wine gives lenght and complexity with a well-balanced acidity to finish off this fresh wine.

#### LEEUWENKUIL RESERVE WHITE 2020 SWARTLAND

#### 322

This wine has a delicate nose of white blossoms, apples, and just a hint of pepper. The palate offers ripe peach and tangy pineapple flavour with an intriguing underlying chalky minerality that lingers on the finish.

## KEERMONT TERRASSE 2021 STELLENBOSCH

#### 590

The Terrasse 2021 has a light green gold colour. The nose is inviting with notes of vanilla, nuts, citrus blossom, and rye. The palate is soft and effortless on entry, but soon opens up with lovely fresh acidity and an array of flavours: ripe apricot, peach and quince flavours complimented by richer more spicy savoury fruit. This follows into a lingering sweetsour aftertaste with a light phenolic grip. A thin line of salty acidity and gentle leesy mouthfeel give the wine a lingering succulent finish.

#### TOKARA DIRECTOR'S RESERVE 2020 STELLENBOSCH

#### 790

This wine displays a pale straw colour with striking brilliance that catches the light. The nose is complex exhibiting attractive notes of ripe passion fruit and pink grapefruit all intermingled with hints of lemon grass and freshly baked brioche. On the palate the wine enters full and rich reminiscent of the aromas on the nose. The wine has amazing clarityand depth with a zesty persistence.





South Africa's own grape – a cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsault (Hermitage) that was created by Stellenbosch University's first Professor of Viticulture, Professor Abraham Izak Perold, in 1925. The first commercial bottling of this variety was done at Lanzerac from the 1959 vintage and the wine was released in 1961. This Pinotage was voted the best wine at the Cape Young Wine Show in 1961, leading to many producers developing some interest in making wine from this variety. When young, Pinotage wines are packed with plum and berry flavours, which then soften and develop associations with prunes, cherries and cassis, as well as red and black berries. Usually medium-to full-bodied, sometimes with a sweet sensation on the finish, and with a complexity that makes Pinotage age well for up to 10 years and more.

#### LANZERAC PIONIER PINOTAGE 2021 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

#### 488 | 1950

The Lanzerac Pionier Pinotage is a tribute to the first world's first bottled Pinotage - a 1959 Lanzerac Pinotage. The 2021 Pionier has an excellent deep colour, with typical varietal aromas like ripe, plummy red fruit on the nose and palate. A big mouth-feel, complex and velvety pallet and long and lingering aftertaste rounds off this wine perfectly. With 5 to 10 years maturation the Pionier Pinotage 2021 will start to acquire the velvet density and luxurious chocolate and caramel flavours for which its predecessors is known.

#### LANZERAC 2021 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

#### 92 | 365

Matured for 16 months in French oak. Smoky soft top notes combine with black plums and sweet cherries, raspberries, prunesand hints of vanilla. Juicy, well-integrated tannins support a spicy, meaty core with a refreshing acidity and a long, smooth finish with hints of polish and leather.

#### LANZERAC 1959 COMMEMORATIVE PINOTAGE 2019 STELLENBOSCH

#### 2800

Grapes from a single block, planted in 1953. Sixty years later the reincarnation of the 1959 vintage, displays some of the same characteristics as the original. Red and blackberries with hints of tea leaf, combined with an earthiness and finishing with soft silky tannins speak to its ancestors, namely Pinot Noir and Cinsaut.

#### MEERENDAL 2016/20 CAPE TOWN

#### **350**

The wine has a deep, dark ruby colour with sweet fruit and some spice and dark chocolate on the nose. It displays juicy red and black berry flavours on the palate with soft tannins and has a classic dry, elegant finish.

#### RIJKS 'CELLAR SELECTION' 2019 TULBAGH

#### 850

This deep coloured wine shows intense black berry, mulberry and slight cigar box notes on the nose. Beautiful floral tones followed by layers of red fruits. The palate is balanced between a dense core of fruit, bright acidity and fine tannins. The finish is long and pure with delicate wood spice rounding off this exceptional Pinotage.

#### FLAGSTONE 'WRITER'S BLOCK' 2021 BREEDEKLOOF

#### 960

On the nose a wonderful, balancing of ripe, dark red fruit like mulberry and blackberry, with mocha chocolate and Indian spice, underpinned by a bewitching hint of bramble and mint. The palate is surprisingly rich, beautifully balanced and gives the impression of being elegant and powerful at the same time. Flavours of very ripe strawberry, cherry and darker blackberry are wrapped up in soft, comforting oak hints and a caress of vanilla and dark chocolate. Really long and luscious.

#### SPIOENKOP 2021 ELGIN

#### 1 282

It's a racy, cool climate expression of the grape, with tangy red cherry and raspberry fruit, stony intensity, whole bunch spices and a hint of good reduction.

## B VINTNERS 2021 STELLENBOSCH

#### **790**

Elegance, freshness and finesse are key, however still maintaining the concentration. Red and black fruits, flowers, herbs, spice and earth, giving layered complexity. The palate follows through with fruit concentration – fine, dense and structured tannin, with wonderfully fresh acidity.





Merlot is one of the primary grapes in Bordeaux, where it is the most widely planted variety. It was introduced to the Cape winelands around 1910, although it was only from the mid–1980s that the wine 'took off' as a variety bottled on its own. It remains a popular component in the country's Bordeaux-style blends, and is grown throughout most of the winelands, though predominantly in Stellenbosch and Paarl. The wine usually appears as dark purple or blue coloured, and has a fresh and fruity taste, full of red fruits.

#### LANZERAC 2022 JONKERSHOEK STELLENBOSCH

#### 85 | 340

This appetising wine has concentrated black-berried fruit edged with sweet vanilla hints and spicy aromas on the nose. Savoury tannins add layers of complexity, gently supporting the flavours of plums, black cherries, cooked strawberries and dark chocolate before a long, integrated finish rounds the wine off.

### SYDNEY BACK KOSHER 2021/22 PAARL

#### 550

This aromatic kosher merlot is pasteurized and prepared under supervision of the Cape Town Beth Din. This wine is Mevushal and Kosher for Passover. With Aromas of rasberry and red plum combined with successful fruit flavours and finely coated tannins ensure a pleasurable drinking experience.

## VERGELEGEN 2017/18 STELLENBOSCH

#### 700

A ripe plum colour with a ruby rim, the nose shows ripe fruit flavours of black cherries and plums, spice and a touch of chocolate. The ripeness of the fruit is balanced by fresh fruit acidity with soft wood and fruit tannins. The aftertaste is long and lasting.

#### MEERENDAL 2022 DURBANVILLE, CAPE TOWN

#### 340

Indulge in the smooth embrace of our Merlot, where juicy plum and red cherry flavours take centre stage. Soft tannins and a touch of vanilla contribute to a velvety texture, while the finish is invitingly lingering.

#### SHANNON MOUNT BULLET 2019/20 ELGIN

#### 1400

Considerable emphasis is placed on maximising the different clone expressions and therefore each parcel is vinified and matured separately before final blending. The wine has a fragrance of ripe red fruits such as plums and dark cherries, with earthy complexity and yet still expressing minerality. Maintaining a good acidity lends to outstanding freshness with a wellintegrated ripe and seductive tannin structure. Incorporating a minimal winemaking intervention approach, such as natural ferment and only two "punch downs" daily, retains silkiness and elegance.

#### CHRISTOPHE PICHON COTE ROTIE ROZIER 2020 COTE ROTIE, RHONE, FRANCE

#### 3 411

Sourced from 50-year-old vines planted on schist soils, this is a gloriously concentrated Syrah packed with luminous cassis and blackberry flavours. Prominent oak tones of smoke, vanilla and cacao are balanced by pristine fruit and a bristling acidic edge. It's lovely in its youth but should develop depth and complexity through 2030 and hold further still.

#### DRIEHOEK 2021 CEDERBERG

#### 670

Dark brooding purple black colour alludes to the opulent nose of ripe plums and mulberries and a kaleidoscope of black fruits and berries. The palate is surprisingly linear and savoury with black pepper spiciness and herbaceous edge. Refreshing acidity holds the ripe fruit at bay and together with the subtle tannins renders a focused wine of opulence and intrigue. A complex wine that reveals more with every sip!

#### GLEN CARLOU 2021 PAARL

#### 590

The nose on this wine is wide-ranging with upfront berry fruits and a lavender perfumed background supported by sweet warm spice. Subtle black peppercorn, cumin and a hint of star anise add complexity to the aromatics. Wonderfully structured tanninson the palate reveal a well-balanced wine made in a definitive style with an unmistakable Rhone reference. Preservation of good natural acidity lends to outstanding freshness on the harmonious yet bold mid-palate.

#### HARTENBERG GRAVEL HILL 2006/7 (OLD & RARE) STELLENBOSCH

#### 4500

A dark-centred, black-red and rubyrimmed Shiraz. Elegant black fruit with violets, cloves, smokiness and black pepper on the bouquet. The palate shows sweet ripe fruit, spicy oak and rich, dry tannins made for the long haul. The palate ends with a lingering savoury finish – all iron fist in a velvet glove.

#### NICOLAS VAN DER MERWE 2019 STELLENBOSCH

#### 1150

Sumptuously packed with red and black berries with spice aromas yet neatly refined. The palate is full-bodied but elegant with soft tannins. A dense mid-palate is full of black fruit and mocha hints with a long beeswax finish. This Syrah is more Rhône style and less blockbuster.

#### TAMBOERSKLOOF 2019 STELLENBOSCH

#### 651

A bright clear medium ruby colour. The nose, starting with violets, evolves into blackberry and bramble. The palate is vibrant with a touch of complex spices, like freshly crushed black pepper and liquorice.

## STRYDOM ROCK STAR 2021 STELLENBOSCH

#### **570**

An elegantly styled Syrah with vibrant and harmoniously layering of blackberry, white pepper and exotic spice flavours. The palate is softly textured and beautifully balanced.

They are multi-dimensional with layers of raspberries, blackberries and blackcurrants, full of mixed spices, leathery with dark chocolate flavours, rich and smoky oakiness, and sometimes a hint of tar.

## BOSCHKLOOF 2021 STELLENBOSCH

#### 615

Complex and attractive bouquet of oriental spices with pronounced violet and white pepper flavours. It has lovely perfumed red fruit aromatics. A well-balanced wine with spicy overtones and a lingering finish. Very classic style with unmistakable Rhone flavours.

#### MULLINEUX SCHIST 2019/22 SWARTLAND

#### 3 183

The adapted natural resilience of the dry land SCHIST Syrah on Roundstone, has resulted in this wine showing pure freshness and superb concentration. The aromas show beautiful hints of Bergamot orange, fragrant dark African violets and nutmeg and the palate is lead by well-structured and harmonious Schist-derived firm tannins.

#### MOUNT SUTHERLAND 2018 SUTHERLAND, KAROO

#### 900

Continental style Syrah. Layers of aromas such as rose petals, black cherries, cloves and freshly milled white pepper. Succulence and richness on the palate and ends in a pleasant, long and ripe finish.





Cabernet Sanvignon

Described as the 'King of Grapes', Cabernet is associated with some of France's finest, with Bordeaux considered to be its home. This popular variety has been cultivated throughout the world's major wine-producing countries. It is bottled on its own but is also often blended with Cabernet Franc and/or Merlot, with some combinations also including Petit Verdot and/or Malbec. No record exists to confirm Cabernet Sauvignon's first arrival in South Africa, although it is likely that the variety has been here for over 200 years. By the 1920s it had become one of the country's top-quality red varieties and today it is grown in virtually all of the wine-producing areas. South Africa has made itself one of the go-to countries for consumers looking for a deep red wine with all the traditional flavour of a French Bordeaux. It has become a specialist at producing award-winning Cabernet Sauvignons which are prized by wine connoisseurs all over the world, yielding the familiar aromas and flavours of blackcurrant, cedarwood and lead pencil shavings, with perhaps a whiff of sweet vanilla oak. South African Cabernet is also known to show additional aromas and flavours of green pepper, mint, dark chocolate, tobacco and cloves. As it matures, it takes on the aroma of a forest floor.

#### LANZERAC 2020 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

#### 92 | 365

A classic Cabernet. Black fruits abound with black cherries, currants and berries coming to the fore, all edged with hints of olive tapenade, dark chocolate and sun-dried tomato notes. Soft, supple tannins and freshening acidity add to the concentrated fruit.

#### SPRINGFIELD MÉTHODE ANCIENNE 2016 ROBERTSON (OLD & RARE)

#### 1200

A wine that is enjoying its time in the bottle. Still showing beautiful fruit of dark berries and plums accompanied by hints of leather, and tobacco on the nose. Bold but delicate fruit, with some ripe plums and tobacco in the fine long finish.

#### NEIL ELLIS 2001 STELLENBOSCH

#### 1200

Its distinctive style, with all the hallmarks of the Jonkershoek Valley, represents a balance of elegance and power. The nose shows restraint with deep underlying aromas of complex blue and black berry perfumes with a fresh palate followed by fine, smooth tannins.

#### LE RICH 2022 STELLENBOSCH

#### 780

Vibrant aromas of blackberry, plums, fresh cherry and hints of cassis and spice. The palate shows sweet fruit on entry followed by a delicious red and black fruit pastilles complexity. Firm tannins and balanced acidity assist in creating a voluptuous midbodied mouthfeel. A long finish is complemented with hints of dark chocolate, black cherry and cedar. A classic Stellenbosch Cabernet Sauvignon.

#### KLEINE ZALZE VINEYARD SELECTION 2021 STELLENBOSCH

#### 520

This wine is a classically structured Cabernet that showcases its provenance. Upfront herbal notes open up in the glass, to reveal intense dark fruit. These flavours follow on the palate with cassis and black cherries being supported by a subtle herbaceous note. An elegantly structured wine with fine tannins and beautifully integrated oak that lingers almost unendingly on the back palate. A fantastic companion to most meat dishes and will also reward careful cellaring for at least 10 years.

#### CEDERBERG FIVE GENERATIONS 2019/20 CEDERBERG

#### 1900

This refined Cabernet Sauvignon surpasses expectations with its rich nose of red and black berries. complemented by blackcurrants, mint leaves, and spicy peppery notes. The palate offers black pastilles embraced by silky tannins and balanced acidity, resulting in a chalky, linear finish. While accessible now, aging will enhance the true pleasure of this wine. It promises great potential for aging and can be decanted for immediate enjoyment. With its refined, silky, and elegant nature, this is the epitome of classic. cool-climate Cabernet.

#### FLAGSTONE MUSIC ROOM 2019 WESTERN CAPE

#### 960

Deep purple colour. On the nose blueberry, cassis, and ripe black plum mix with cool cedar whiffs and the faintest hint of basil – all wrapped up in serious, warm, toasty oak. The palate is all about chunky, chewy, magically integrated tannin. Luxurious deep-pile velvet fruit with mint-sprigged red berries and Christmas fruitcake. A blockbuster Cabernet.





Cabernet Franc & Grenache

#### **CABERNET FRANC**

Cabernet Franc is one of the major red grape varieties worldwide. It is principally used for blending with Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot in the Bordeaux style but can also be found as a single varietal bottling. Cabernet Franc is one of the genetic parents of Cabernet Sauvignon although it is lighter, making bright pale red wines, and contributing finesse and a peppery perfume to blends with more robust grapes. Depending on the region and style of wine, additional aromas can include tobacco, raspberry, and cassis – sometimes even violets.

#### RAINBOW'S END 'SPECIAL RELEASE' 2017 STELLENBOSCH

#### 990

Deep red in colour with liquorice and cherries on the nose, and ripe red fruit with hints of spice on the palate. A rich, smooth mouthfeel with a lingering finish.

## CHAMONIX 2021 FRANSCHHOEK

#### 570

Intense bouquet with scents reminiscent of Dark fruit, red berries, spice, and cigar box. A wine of ample structure fills the mouth with concentrated fruit and berry sensations.

#### ZORGVLIET 2020 STELLENBOSCH

#### 477

The wine shows cinnamon and spice characteristics on the nose, which are well integrated with flavours of black cherry and plum fruit on the palate.

#### **GRENACHE**

One of the world's most widely planted grape varieties, Grenache is a quintessentially Mediterranean red-wine variety. It originated in the northern province of Aragon, Spain, and spread to Rioja and Navarra. Grenache is also the dominant variety in most southern Rhône wines, especially Châteauneuf-du-Pape, wherein it is typically over 80% of the blend. Grenache is also used to make rosé wines in France and Spain, notably those of the Travel district in the Côtes du Rhône. Single variety Grenache wines are increasingly being produced in South Africa with success, with areas such as Piekenierskloof and Swartland being well-reputed sources for premium grapes. These wines display distinctive black pepper and spice – the cloves, nutmeg and cinnamon of a Christmas cake – with red plummy fruit.

#### DAVID & NADIA 2022 SWARTLAND

#### 880

This scented, refined, very lightly wooded Grenache has lots of granite-derived freshness and minerality, red cherry, raspberry and pomegranate flavours and succulent, textured tannins.

#### NEIL ELLIS 2010 PIEKENIERSKLOOF

#### 880

Vibrant crimson colour. Perfumed and spicy with rich plummy fruit. A medium bodied palate with good weight. Fine grained fruit tannins complement a rich concentrated palate.

### PIEKENIERSKLOOF 2023 PIEKENIERSKLOOF

#### 359

Lots of juicy red berry and strawberry fruit. Well balanced with lively fine tannins and an elegant complexity on a long finish





Pinot Noir 'took root' in the Côte d'Or in the heart of the Burgundy region in France in the 4th century AD, and in Champagne, where it is traditionally blended with Chardonnay. Of all red wines, Pinot Noir is the one that is associated with the most elegance due to its ability to combine a low tannin structure with a whole spectrum of upfront fruit flavours of raspberries, strawberries, cherries and cranberries, as well as violets and roses.

#### EDOUARD DELAUNAY 2019 NUITS-SAINT-GEORGES

#### 3 000

Graceful deep red colour with bluish nuances. Nose with slightly smoky scents of tea and incense, with more woody and mineral notes. Very nice attack in mouth, where notes of gingerbread, toast, blackcurrant liquor and chocolate powder combine harmoniously. It is an incredibly complex and expressive wine, which will reveal all its potential with ageing.

#### HAMILTON RUSSELL 2022/23 WALKER BAY

#### 1700

Our low-vigour, stony, clay-rich soil, cool maritime mesoclimate, naturally tiny yields of well under 35 hl/ha and our philosophy of expressing our terroir in our wines – give rise to a certain tightness, tannin line and elevated length to balance the richness and generosity of our Pinot noir. Our Pinot noir is not overtly fruity, soft and "sweet" and it generally shows hints of that alluring savoury "primal" character along with a dark, spicy, complex primary fruit perfume.

#### CATHERINE MARSHALL ON CLAY SOILS 2023 ELGIN

#### 620

Layered and textured truffle savouriness and earthy forest floor interwoven with concentrated black cherry compote harmoniously supported by mineral textured tannins.

#### NEWTON JOHNSON WALKER BAY 2023 WALKER BAY

#### 690

Perfumed layers of red fruits; the warm, rich spice and woody notes mingle with earthy mushroom and dried flower characters. The generous and polished palate is gripped with fine, chalky tannins. Ripe raspberry fruit provides some flesh to the mid palate, with long savoury liquorice flavour in the finish.

### SUTHERLAND 2020 ELGIN

#### 535

This Pinot Noir was aged in French oak barrels for 9 months and shows pure strawberry fruit aromas and lovely perfumed spice and earthy characters on the nose. The wine is wonderfully balanced with a long refined finish.





This is a deep-coloured grape long known as one of the five varieties allowed in the blend of red Bordeaux wine. The French plantations of Malbec are now very few and found primarily in Cahors in the southwestern region of France. It is increasingly celebrated as an Argentine varietal wine and is being grown around the world. While the variety can be harsh and tannic in France (usually needing Merlot to soften it), in Argentina, where it is grown extensively, it produces a softer, juicier style of red. In South Africa it produces a plummy, meaty wine, with intense raspberry and mulberry fruit undertones.

## DOOLHOF BLOEDKLIP 2018 WELLINGTON

#### 2 358

The nose of this wine is richly dense and savoury with hints of plum, black truffle and appears slightly rustic, almost reminiscent of an old-world classic. The fruit remains pure and concentrated and follows through with well- rounded and well-balanced tannins.

#### DOOLHOF SINGLE VINEYARD 2022 WELLINGTON

#### 558

Intense garnet to dark purple in colour with vibrant aromas of violets, cocoa, and blackcurrant. The palate shows richness and roundness, with flavours of blackberries and plums.

#### PAUL WALLACE BLACK DOG 2019 ELGIN

#### 543

Much like the dog the wine is dark in colour, well-muscled intense and full of character. The Black Dog Malbec presents with an intriguing somewhat exotic nose, conjuring up hints of blue berries, black berries, bramble, rhubarb and dark chocolate. The entry onto the palate is a satisfying fruit-filled mouthful of dark fruits linked by a thread of white pepper and nutmeg and held together with amiable tannins - just enough to contribute to food friendliness. The Black Dog Malbec is a truly memorable wine which reflects the natural elegance we have come to expect from Elgin wines.

#### RAKA 2021 KLEIN RIVER

#### 553

A fragrant Malbec with plums, blackberries and cassis and a smoky tone on the nose. The same fruit flavours carry through on the palate and the plum makes for juicy and jammy tannins complimented by well-integrated oak with a lingering finish.





A classic grape variety that is mostly used to add extra power and weight behind the famous Bordeaux-style blends. On their own, these wines are ageworthy and show excellent quality although they require time to settle and enable the taut tannins to mellow. They are concentrated, tannic wines, deep in colour, with ripe berry fruits and they bring a whole range of flavours of strawberry, blueberry, black olive, liquorice, violet and oregano.

#### STELLENBOSCH VINEYARDS 'THE FLAGSHIP' 2015 STELLENBOSCH

#### 920

Deep and rich exemplifying the robust and intense nature of Petit Verdot. This deep ruby-hued wine offers intense dark cherry and blackcurrant flavours with great fruit purity. It has refreshing acidity and rich, complex savoury support. With a succulent and rich mouthfeel coating the mouth for a long after taste of warm spices and dried fruit.

## ZORGVLIET 2019/20 STELLENBOSCH

#### 477

Dark plum coloured with coriander, cloves and fruit cake on the nose. The wine shows dark plum and prune fruit on the palate.

#### LE BONHEUR 2020 STELLENBOSCH

#### 1134

The Le Bonheur Petit Verdot Reserve is renowned for its intense colour, fragrant notes of violets, black berries and dried spices. A collector's item that will benefit from cellaring of up to 20 years.

#### RAKA 2020 KLEIN RIVER

#### 553

A dark plum colour. While the bouquet & palate gives you red berries - cherry and cranberry - on the nose, violets and white pepper. The palate is rich with darker fruits and a dry tannin finish.

#### NEDERBERG PRIVATE BIN R104 PETIT VERDOT 2010 WESTERN CAPE

#### 920

Concentrated dark berries, coffee, cocao and leather. Tertiary elements is slowly settling into this dense and masculine Petit that still has mouthcoating tannins that is unyielding, while the flavour profile is mature. A structured, dry, bold red that will go well with hard, full flavoured dishes.





Cinsault comes from France, where it is spelt Cinsault, not Cinsaut. It is grown mainly in the south, from Provence to the Midi. The variety was imported from the south of France in the mid-19th century and, until the rise of Cabernet Sauvignon in the late 20th century, it was the single most widely planted red cultivar in South Africa at a time when it was better known as Hermitage. Cinsault is used chiefly as a blending component but single varietal bottlings are increasing again. It owes its popularity among farmers to its ability to withstand hot growing conditions and produces wines that have become favourites with chefs and sommeliers alike because of their pairing abilities.

#### KELDERMEESTER VERSAMELING KURKTREKKER 2022 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

#### 735

This wine has a floral nose with supple, fruity undertones. The palate is silky with an understated length, owing to the use of 100% Cinsaut from a higher altitude vineyard in lonkershoek.

#### NEIL ELLIS 2015/17 GROENEKLOOF

#### **720**

Medium in colour with a bright crimson hue, this wine portrays a complex mix of red fruits, spicy notes and perfume. Interesting complexity is gained from subtle ageing in oak. The palate is bright and youthful with cherry and fruit tart flavours. Fine grainy tannins add to the structure of the wine, leading to an elegant finish.

#### VAN LOGGERENBERG LOTTER 2023 FRANSCHHOEK

#### 1758

The wine is made from the second oldest red wine vineyard in the country. The vineyard was planted in 1932 by Koos Lötter on his farm located in Franschhoek. These old bush vines are dryland farmed and produce exceptional fruit. The soils are decomposed granite with under laying sandstone which gives this wine its elegance and finesse.

#### AA BADENHORST RINGMUUR 2022 SWARTLAND

#### 1750

The Ringmuur vineyard was planted in 1963 on decomposed granite soils surrounded on two sides by an old farm ring wall. Made using carbonic maceration for 20 days in a closed tank, then transferred to a large old vat for another approximate 11 months. With cherries and rose petals on the nose it is light and elegant, yet has the typical dry Cinsault tannin grip on finish. A real unicorn wine from the Swartland!

#### WATERKLOOF SERIOUSLY COOL 2022 STELLENBOSCH

#### 450

The old bush vines gave rise to a soft, vibrant and yet structured wine. It is playful in its aromas with loads of red berries, pronounced florals and slight earthy notes. In the mouth, the prominent fruit aromatics are complemented by soft tannins with great length.





## Nebbiolo & Zinfandel / Primitivo

#### **NEBBIOLO**

A native of the northwestern region of Piedmont, this variety produces some of the best quality wines in Italy. A variety that prefers cooler conditions, Nebbiolo has experienced some problems with sunburn in South African vineyards. Steenberg from Constantia has included a single varietal Nebbiolo in its portfolio since the late 1990s that is a yardstick for this variety. Wines offer a perfumed nose with plum, strawberry and fruit aromas, and upfront blackberry and dark cherry flavours. A full-flavoured, excellent food wine.

#### STEENBERG 2018 CONSTANTIA

#### 680

The nose initially shows a savoury aroma reminiscent of heirloom tomato relish. This is followed by hues of aniseed and dried porcini mushrooms along with some sour cherry, rooibos tea leaf, rose petal and bran. The wine displays the natural tart acidity and grippy tannins of Nebbiolo on the palate, although with a well-rounded

and lighter mouth-feel than can sometimes be the case with this varietal. The bright, fresh palate eases off to reveal a classic Nebbiolo varietal character: sour cherry, raspberry and tobacco leaf linger to give the wine brilliant length and persistence.

#### ZINFANDEL / PRIMITIVO

Zinfandel is thought to be of European origin and is the same variety as Italy's Primitivo. However, as California's most widely planted red-wine grape at one stage, today it is synonymous with these winelands, where it has been planted since the mid-1880s. In South Africa, plantings are still small and are largely confined to Stellenbosch and Paarl, where they have been around since the 1970s. The variety is associated with rich fruitiness, and dark berry fruit and cherries are often the ones most easily identified. A nose of brambly fruit flavours can develop into a rich, spicy stew with time. Another distinctive aroma is raisins.

#### IDIOM 2018 STELLENBOSCH

#### 700

Silky and spicy. This elegant, medium-bodied expression of Stellenbosch Zinfandel, also known as Primitivo, exhibits a superb power-to-weight ratio. Aromas of candied raspberry and hibiscus dominate the nose. An effortless entry leads to an explosive revolving tray of bay leaf, tobacco leaf and mulberry flavours dancing on the palate. A refreshing wine with an attractive long finish.

## HESS SELECT 2013 CALIFORNIA, USA

#### 970

Generous aromas of sweet purple plums, blackberries, blueberries and brambleberries with some underbrush as a backdrop. While this is a big Zinfandel, it is also balanced and elegant. Blackberry and black raspberry notes with a hint of vanilla on the finish.





Sangiouese & Tempranillo

#### **SANGIOVESE**

From central Italy, Sangiovese is the Chianti grape par excellence, responsible in Tuscany for the famous Chianti Classico, Brunello di Montalcino and Vino Nobile di Montepulciano wines. A relative newcomer to the Cape with only a few vineyards planted, interesting single varietal wines have been made by a few producers.

#### IDIOM 2018/19 STELLENBOSCH

#### 690

An enticing and emotive wine. This modern and elegant Stellenbosch Sangiovese presents tantalising nose and complex mouthfeel. Initial signature sweet and sour cherry flavours develop into riper, darker fruit notes. Complex gravel, tomato leaf and cinnamon notes combine with savoury spices to enhance the sweet and sour profile of Sangiovese. A silky, well-balanced wine to treasure and enjoy. Try with pork belly and Fiorentina steak.

#### **TEMPRANILLO**

Tempranillo, also known as Tinta Roriz in Portugal, is the noblest red grape variety of Spain's Rioja region. The grape takes its name from the Spanish word for early, 'temprano', as it tends to ripen early. In Rioja the variety is famous for producing dark-coloured wines that are capable of ageing without losing their colour. Tempranillo is said to have arrived in the Cape with famous port varieties such as Tinta Barocca and Souzão some 50 years ago as it is especially well adapted to hot climates. Vastly used locally as a blending component in the wines of various port houses in the country, characteristic flavours include plums, blackcurrants, cassis, tea, brown sugar and vanilla.

#### MARQUES DE MURRIETS GRAND RESERVA 2015 RIOJA

#### 2 761

Over a base of balsamic aromas, there are hints of spices, ripe black berries, cassis, and figs. The delicate aromatic range is completed with mineral and light earth notes. The wine is refined and it has a lively palate, with silky texture that is wrapped by polished tannins and a long, persistent finish. A well-structured wine that has long to live.

#### BALEIA 2018 CAPE SOUTH COAST

#### 450

A lush Tempranillo with black currant, Fynbos and mocha aromas, ripe fruit and smoky flavours. The delicate sensation of minerality present in Baleia's food-driven wines are an expression of the natural salts found in the soils and prepares the palate beautifully.





## Red Blends

Bordeaux Style Blends

#### LE GÉNÉRAL 2020 JONKERSHOEK, STELLENBOSCH

#### 250 | 995

The Lanzerac Le Général is a limited barrel selection of the best red wine of the 2020 vintage. This full-bodied Cabernet-based blend announces vanilla and nutmeg spice before a flood of dark berries, cooked plums and blackcurrants assail the palate. Dark chocolate and hints of smoke is supported by sturdy smooth tannins and an endless finish.

#### LES CHARMES DE KIRWAN 2010 MARGAUX, BORDEAUX, FRANCE

#### 2.450

A deep ruby colour with aromas of plums, blackcurrants, damsons, cedarwood and a touch of leather. On the medium-bodied palate, really agile, nice ripe tannins that are not intrusive balanced by lovely crunchy fruit and good acidity. A very nice cranberry finish.

#### CHATEAU DE FERRAND 2015 SAINT-EMILION

#### 2 583

Staying true to the wines of the Saint-Emillion appellation, Château de Ferrand has a garnet colour and an intense nose of ripe fruit and spice. It is clean in the attack with smooth tannins. It then develops very ripe red fruit, blackcurrant, raspberry and blueberry notes and a lingering, elegant finish.

## CAMBERLEY PHILOSOPHER'S STONE NV STELLENBOSCH

#### 510

A blend of 45% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Cabernet Franc and 15% Merlot. An appealing fruit-laden nose of blackberries and prunes is followed by notes of Sichuan pepper and mint. A concentrated fruity palate with refined elegant tannins and a superb spicy finish.

#### RUSTENBERG JOHN X MERRIMAN 2022 STELLENBOSCH

#### 590

Cassis, black currant and dark fruits complemented with cigar tobacco and sour cherry notes. As the wine ages its fine-grained tannins soften, and a more savoury palate develops.

#### MVEMVE RAATS MR DE COMPOSTELLA 2021 STELLENBOSCH

#### 4 500

Deep, dark and intense ruby colour. Blackcurrant and black cherry fruit with hints of violets, cedar and cinnamon. Rich and complex with mineral, blackberry fruit and dark chocolate on the finish. Harmoniously composed of the five Bordeaux varieties to ensure none dominate. This wine shows a consistent, linear flavour profile with a polished and well-defined finish.



## Red Blends

Chône-Style Blends

#### E GUIGAL 2017 CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE

#### 2643

Very rich wine full of harmony and balance, round tannins with powerful complexity. A rich unctuous wine with notes of mature plums, hazelnuts, spice and red fruits.

#### ORG DE RAC DE WAGHUIS 2021 SWARTLAND (CERTIFIED ORGANIC)

#### 550

Red berry, cherry and plum flavours are immediately discern-able on the nose along with an aromatic hint of white pepper and cinnamon. On the palate the fruit and spice is joined by a savoury earthiness. The mouthfeel is juicy and moreish and a fresh salinity makes a splash on the long finish.

#### NEDERBURG THE MOTORCYCLE MARVEL 2013 WESTERN CAPE (OLD & RARE)

#### 1700

A sumptuous blend of 32% Carignan, 31% Shiraz, 14% Grenache, 13% Cinsault and 10% Mourvèdre. A deep intense ruby red colour, the bouquet has an abundance of sweet spices, ripe red berries and dried fruit characters on the nose. The palate follows with a rich and intense full-bodied explosion of red fruit flavours with ripe and silky tannins. An excellent integration of fruit and wood with a hint of spice to finish.

#### SARONSBERG FULL CIRCLE 2019/20 TULBAGH

#### 1950

This acclaimed wine has a deep, dark purple colour with prominent ripe plum and red berry flavours combined with floral notes and undertones of spice. The oak is well-balanced with full, firm yet accessible tannins. A wine of depth, complexity and grace.





Cape Blends

#### KAAPZICHT STEYTLER VISION 2021 STELLENBOSCH

#### 1550

Red berry, cherry and plum flavours are immediately discern-able on the nose along with an aromatic hint of white pepper and cinnamon. On the palate the fruit and spice is joined by a savoury earthiness. The mouthfeel is juicy and moreish and a fresh salinity makes a splash on the long finish.

#### LYNGROVE PLATINUM LATITUDE 2020 STELLENBOSCH

#### 1950

This "Cape blend" is a full-bodied wine made of Pinotage, Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz. The wine shows depth of colour. The nose entices with hints of black and blueberry, cedar spice, stewed red plum and Herbs de Provence. Rich and flavourful, but defined by structured tannins.
